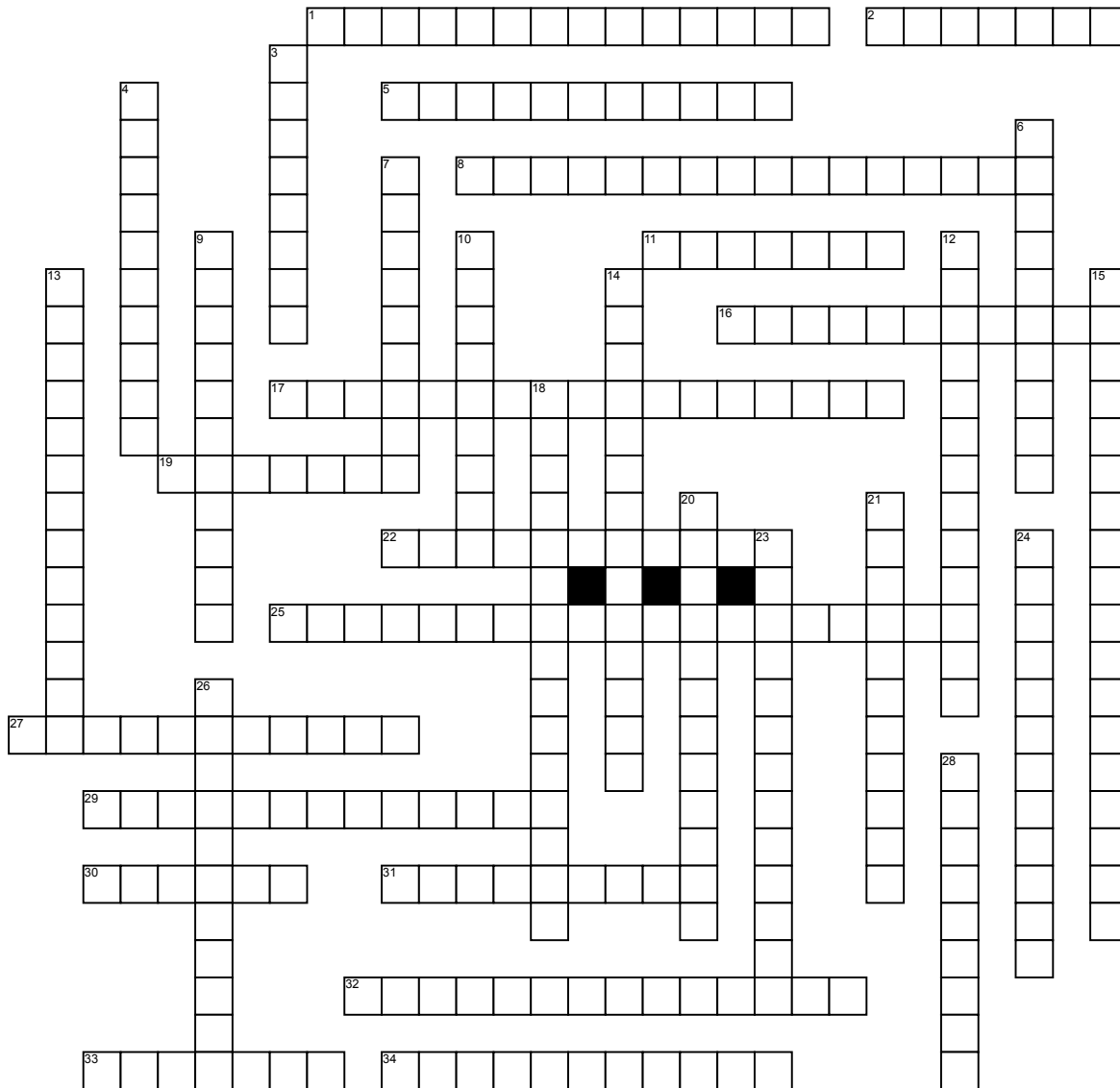

1. the condition caused by excessive quantities of thyroid hormones it may be due to over secretion by the thyroid gland
2. Pertaining to the femur
5. relating to the interaction or cooperation of two or more organizations, substances, or other agents to produce a combined effect greater than the sum of their separate effects
8. a diagnostic test that uses ultrasound waves to create an image of the heart muscle
11. abnormal dryness, as of the eye, skin, or mouth
16. sensitivity to light
17. Suppression of the immune response, as by drugs or radiation, in order to prevent the rejection of grafts or transplants or to control autoimmune diseases
19. A gaseous suspension of fine solid or liquid particles
22. Absence of vision in half of the visual field
25. another term for adrenocorticotrophic hormone
27. a drug, agent, or nerve that can cause dilatation of the walls of blood vessels
29. an abnormally high level of calcium in the blood, usually more than 10.5 milligrams per deciliter of blood
30. a benign fatty tumor usually composed of mature fat cells
31. each end of a long bone; the area beyond the epiphyseal plate

32. Commonly called pinkeye, occurring when blood vessels dilate from allergens like pollen, bacterial infection, or virus

33. Hard protein material found in the epidermis, hair, and nails

34. Radiation therapy administered with the source at a distance from the body

4. microscopic definition of cells that are highly abnormal but not clearly cancerous
6. Immature bone marrow that gives rise to granulocytes
7. Beneath the finger or toe nail
9. the branch of surgery dealing with the preservation and restoration of the function of the skeletal system, its articulations, and associated structures
10. a radiograph of a blood vessel
12. Chronic psychotic disorder that may include hallucinations, disorganized speech and behavior, flat affect, and lack of initiative
13. This sarcoma of the nervous system origin affects infants and children up to the age of ten years, usually arising in immature tissues of the atomic nervous system or adrenal medulla
14. Drooping of the superior eyelid
15. generalized insufficiency of pituitary hormones, resulting from damage to or deficiency of the gland

18. diagnostic technique that projects and retrieves high-frequency sound waves as they echo off parts of the body

20. physician with medical training in the diagnosis, prevention, and treatment of mental disorders

21. a rapidly progressing, life-threatening allergic reaction

23. serving to prevent the clotting of blood

24. an abnormal, unexpected effect of a drug that is peculiar to an individual
