

- **5.** An inflammatory disorder resulting in the ulceration of the lining of the colon and rectum associated with antibiotic use
- **7.** A disorder typically characterized with hallucinations as well as delusional and disordered thoughts
- **8.** A disruption of the electrical impulse generation or conduction in the heart that leads to an abnormal function

- **10.** A patient exhibits a wide array of behavioral characteristics ranging from mild to severe. Deficits in communication and interaction
- 11. A common liver disease
- **12.** A device that is implanted subcutaneously, usually in the clavicle region of the chest wall designed to maintain the heart rate.
