

- **4.** Respiratory rate with fast deep breaths and with irregular apnea
- **5.** Respiratory rate that is greater than 20 breaths per min Down
- **9.** Pulse Rate less than 60 beats per minute
- 10. Respiratory rate that is when arousedless than 12 breaths per minute2. Vibrations that are felt on
- **11.** Irregular breathing rapid breathing with slow shallow and apnea
- **12.** Body temperature that is below normal

- **8.** Tapping the patient chest wall for dull or hyper resonate sounds
