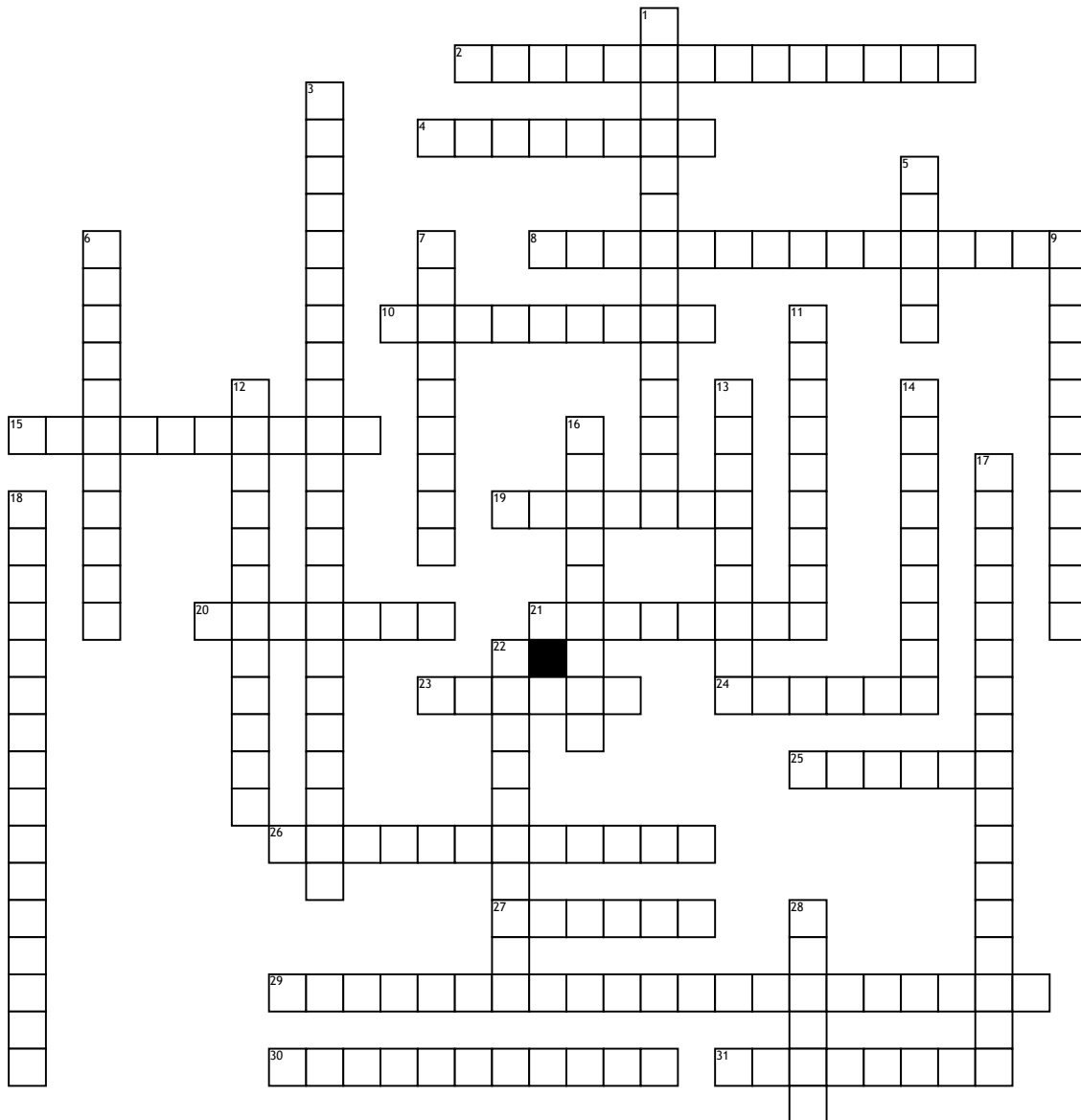


# Medical Terminology



## Across

2. high number of red blood cells, also called erythrocytes  
 4. Creamy yellow, green, white or tan drainage that is thick and opaque  
 8. Pink to Light Red, Watery Drainage  
 10. Bleeding from the nose  
 15. a reduction in the number of white cells in the blood  
 19. painful or difficult urination.  
 20. Having below normal oxygen level in the body tissues and cells  
 21. Frequent urination at night  
 23. decrease below reference range in the total amount of red blood cells or hemoglobin in the blood  
 24. The absence of oxygen from the body/es gasses, blood, or tissues

25. Loss of coordination of voluntary muscle movements.

26. abnormally high concentration of hemoglobin in the blood through an increase in red cell

27. Clear or light yellow drainage

29. Pattern of alternating periods of rapid breathing, slow breathing, and the absence of breathing

30. feeling of "pins and needles"; associated with neuropathy

31. the production of abnormally small amounts of urine

1. Medication that expands the opening of the passages into the lungs

3. When blood pressure drops suddenly upon standing or stretching

5. absence of spontaneous respiration

6. Medication administered to prevent or relieve coughing

7. Having decreased oxygen level in the blood
