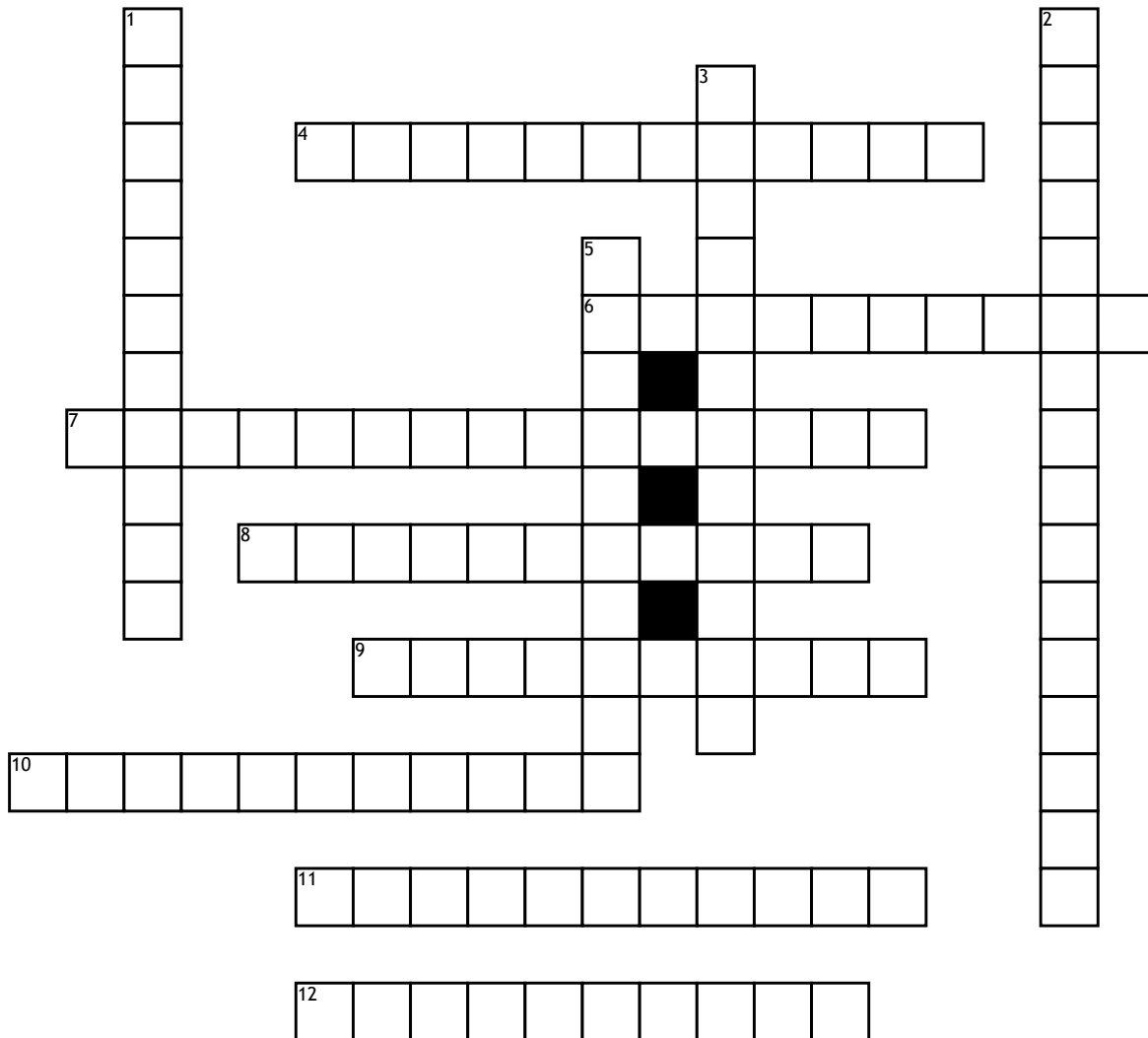

4. Nosebleed, especially one in which bleeding is profuse
 6. the stopping of a flow of blood
 7. the thickening and hardening of the walls of the arteries, occurring typically in old age
 8. a red blood cell that (in humans) is typically a biconcave disc without a nucleus

9. a reduction in the number of white cells in the blood, typical of various diseases
 10. surgical repair or unblocking of a blood vessel, especially a coronary artery
 11. a tracing of the electrical potentials of a tissue (as the brain or heart) made by means of electrodes placed directly in the tissue instead of on the surface of the body
 12. a record of muscle activity within the heart made by a cardiograph
