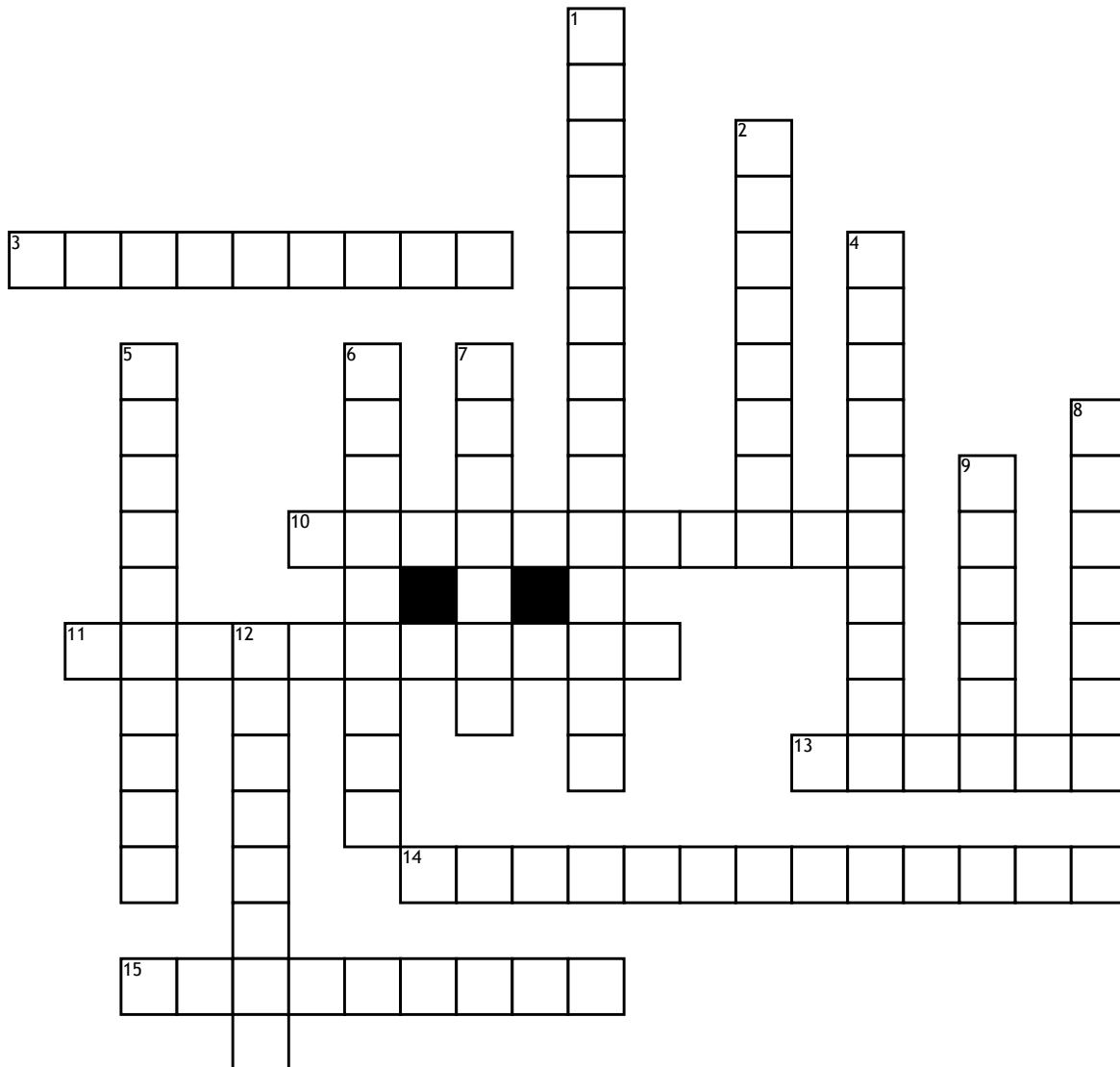

1. A condition caused by excess fluid in the lungs  
 2. discharge of pus  
 4. common office test used to assess how well your lungs work by measuring how much air you inhale  
 5. Inflammation of the lining of bronchial tubes, which carry air to and from the lungs  
 6. Infection that inflames air sacs in one or both lungs, which may fill with fluid

7. a large membranous tube reinforced by rings of cartilage, extending from the larynx to the bronchial tubes and conveying air to and from the lungs; the windpipe  
 8. difficult or labored breathing  
 9. An inflammation of the voice box from overuse, irritation, or infection.
