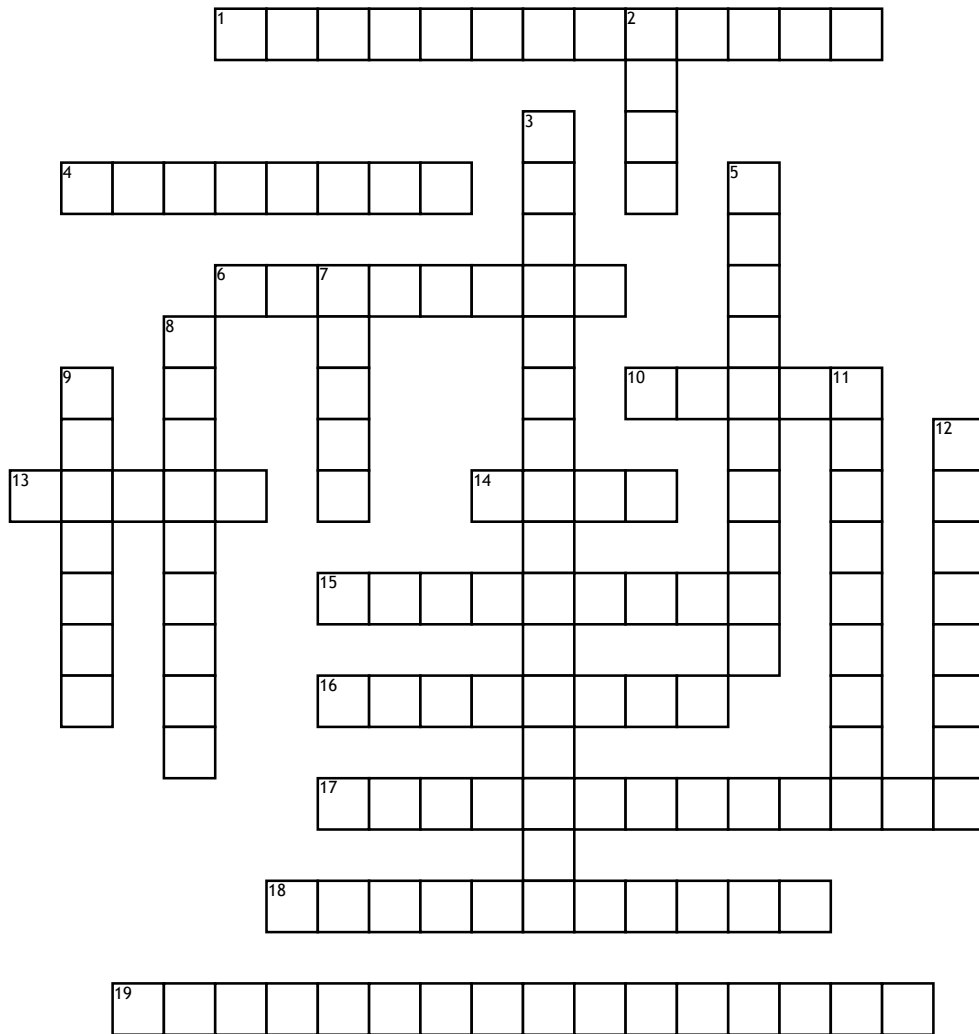

1. Condition characterized by lack of muscle control and partial paralysis  
 4. Largest portion of the brain  
 6. Three layers of membrane that cover the brain and spinal cord  
 10. Encephal/o  
 13. Contained within the cranium

14. Cells that support and nourish nervous tissue

 16. Group of nerve cell bodies  
 17. Disease of the nerve roots  
 18. Tumor composed of developing glia  
 19. Protrusion of the meninges and spinal cord

 2. Connects the cerebrum with the cerebellum and brainstem

 5. Myel/o  
 7. Made up of fibers that carries impulses from one part of the body to another  
 8. Portion of the brain that connects with the spinal cord  
 9. Inflammation of the dura mater  
 11. Radicul/o  
 12. Condition characterized by recurrent seizures
