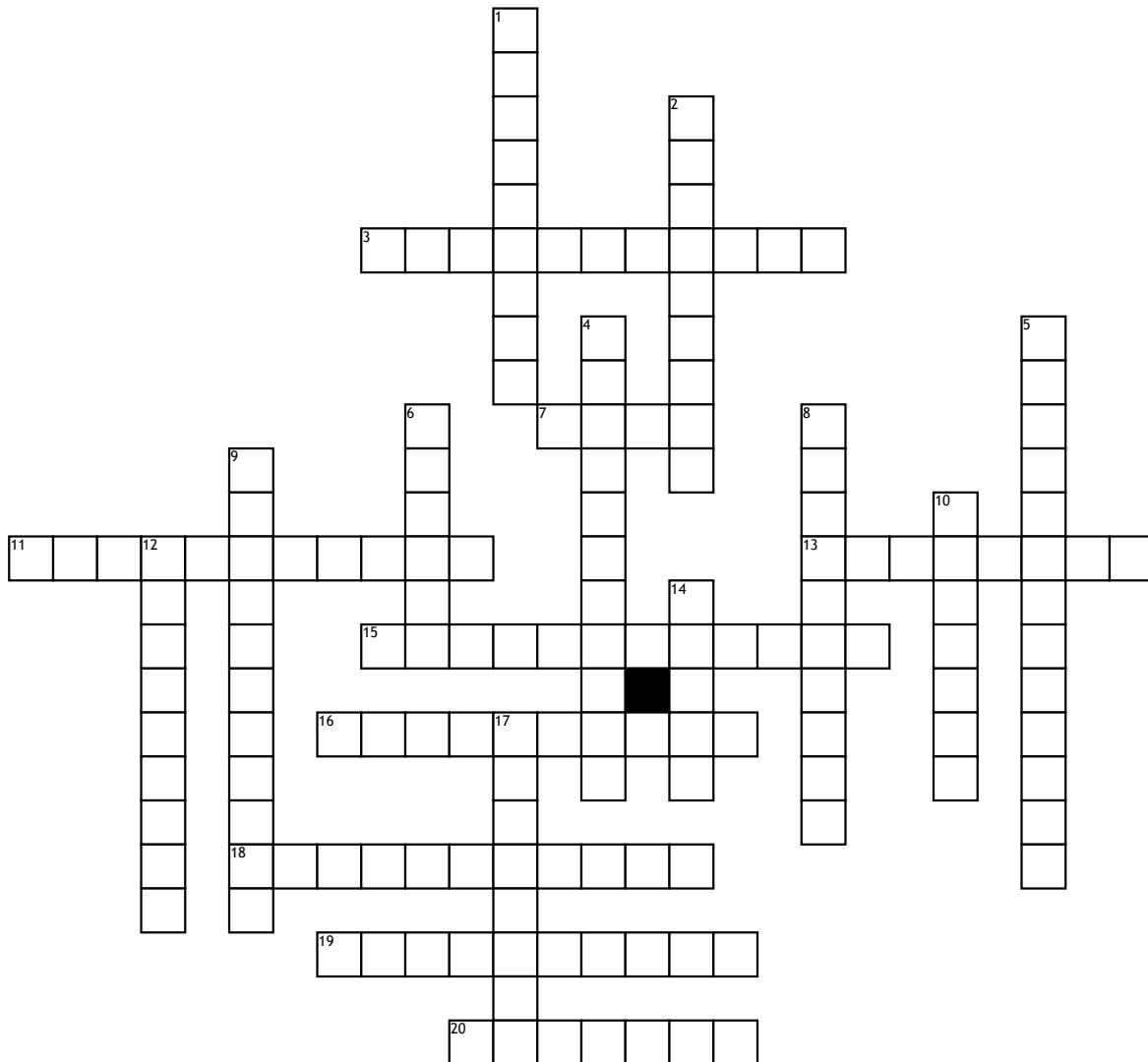


Medical Terminology (Suffix)
