


# Medical Terms #1



## Across

2. Failure of muscle coordination; unable to coordinate muscle movement resulting in jerkiness and incoordination.  
 4. The formation of new blood vessels.  
 9. Excessive amount of urine  
 10. The degree of pathogenicity of a microorganism as indicated by the severity of disease produced and the ability to invade the tissues of the host.  
 13. Flow in the opposite direction than normal, e.g. throwing up of undigested food; backflow of blood through a defective heart valve.  
 14. A substance or condition that impairs normal development of the embryo or fetus in utero causing a congenital abnormality.

15. A toxin or antibody having a specific toxic action upon the cells of special organs.  
 16. The split of a tube or vessel into two branches or channels.  
 17. Inflammation of the meninges.  
 18. Situated toward or pertaining to the tail; toward the inferior or posterior end of the body.

1. A harsh, high-pitched respiratory sound.  
 3. When a segment of one part of the intestine becomes telescoped into an immediately adjacent part.  
 5. Enlargement of the spleen.  
 6. A fever-producing substance.  
 7. The presence of blood in the urine.

8. The liberation of hemoglobin, consisting of separation of the hemoglobin from the red cells and its appearance in plasma.  
 11. Out of place; an object or organ situated in an unusual place away from its normal position.  
 12. An abnormal passage or communication from one organ to another or from an internal organ to the body surface; may be caused by disease or injury or created surgically.
