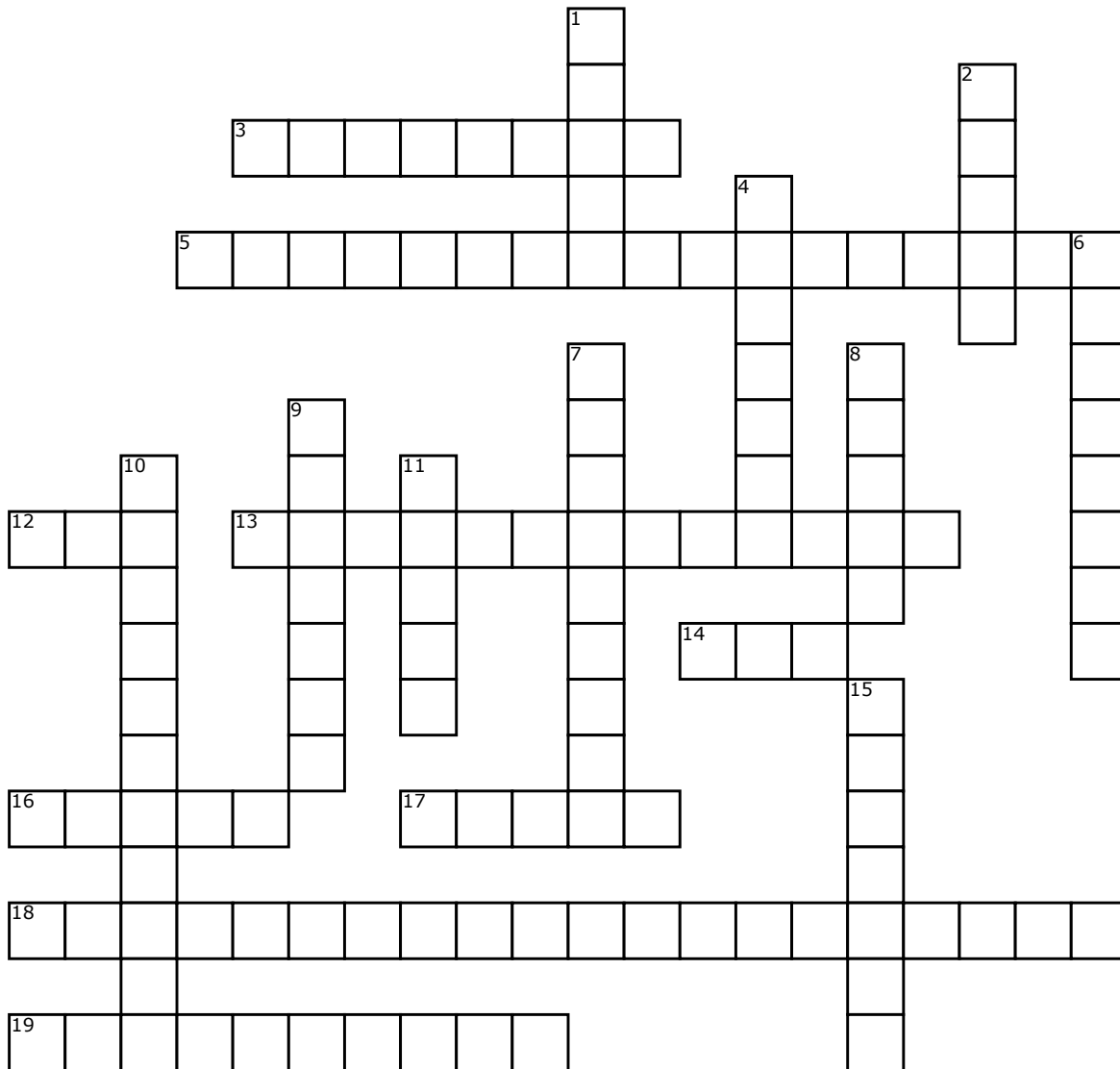

3. Insurance for people aged 65 and older
