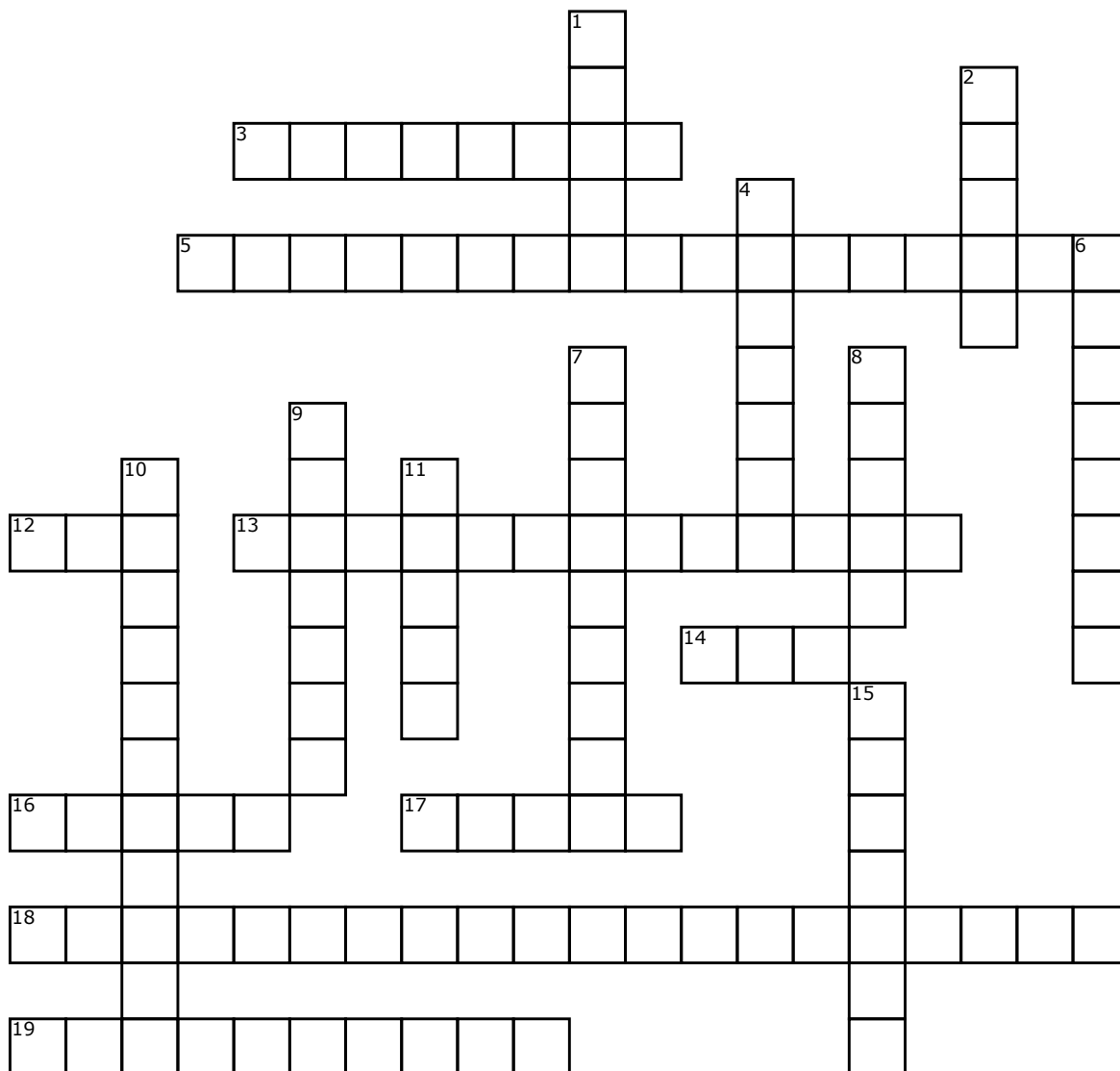

## **Across**

**3.** Insurance for people aged 65 and older

**5.** the doctor you see first for most health problems

**12.** in this plan you can go any doctor or other health providers or hospital and doesn't need a referral

**13.** These include HMO's, PPO's, Private Fee-for-Service Plans, and Special Needs Plans

**14.** in this type of plan you can only go to doctors, other health care providers, or hospitals in the plan's network except in an urgent or emergency situation.

**16.** Medicare that covers physician services

**17.** Medicare that covers hospital and hospice care

**18.** this visit is available once every twelve months after the first twelve months of Part B coverage

**19.** services to prevent illness or detect illness at an early stage
