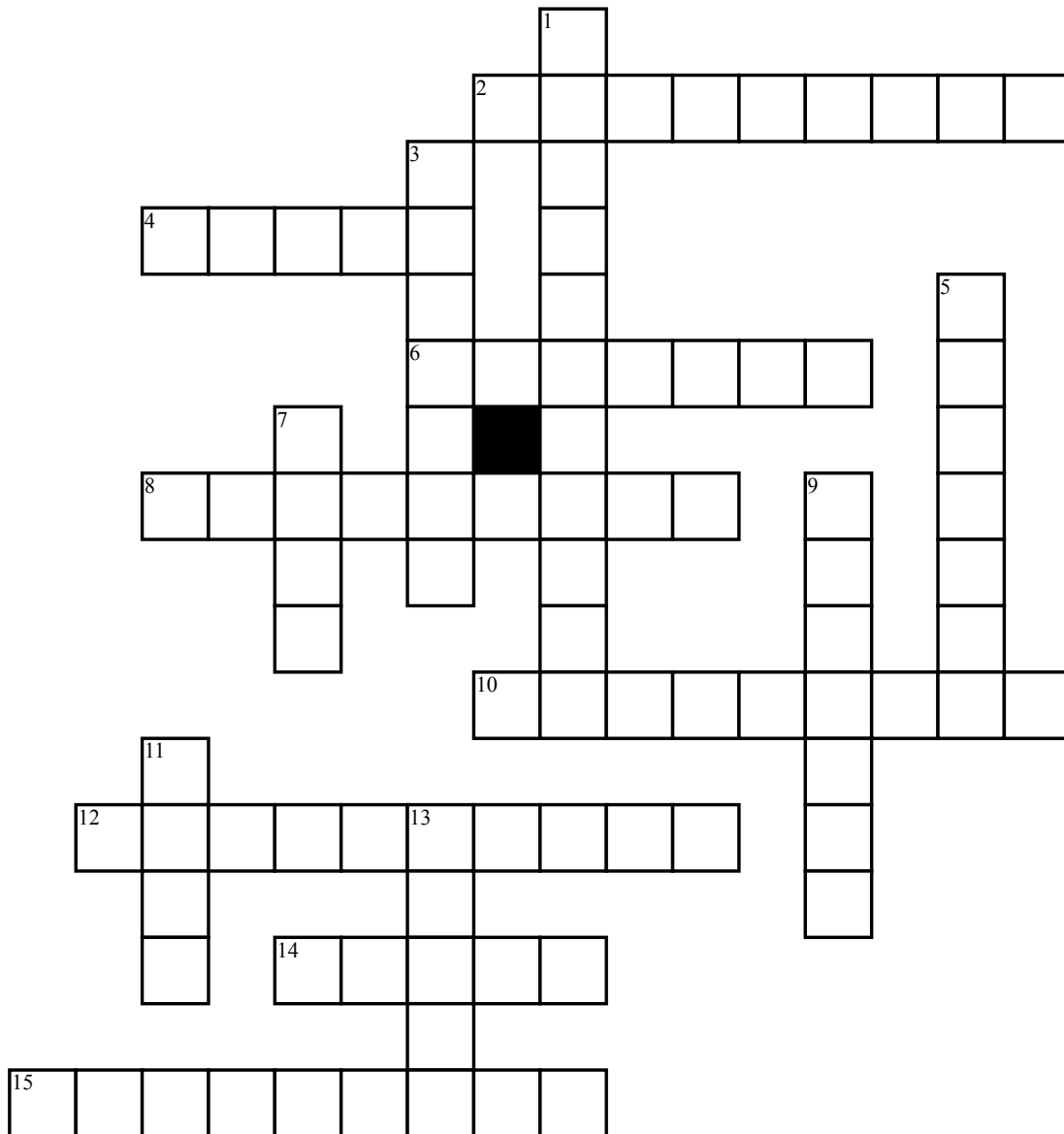


Medieval Crossword
