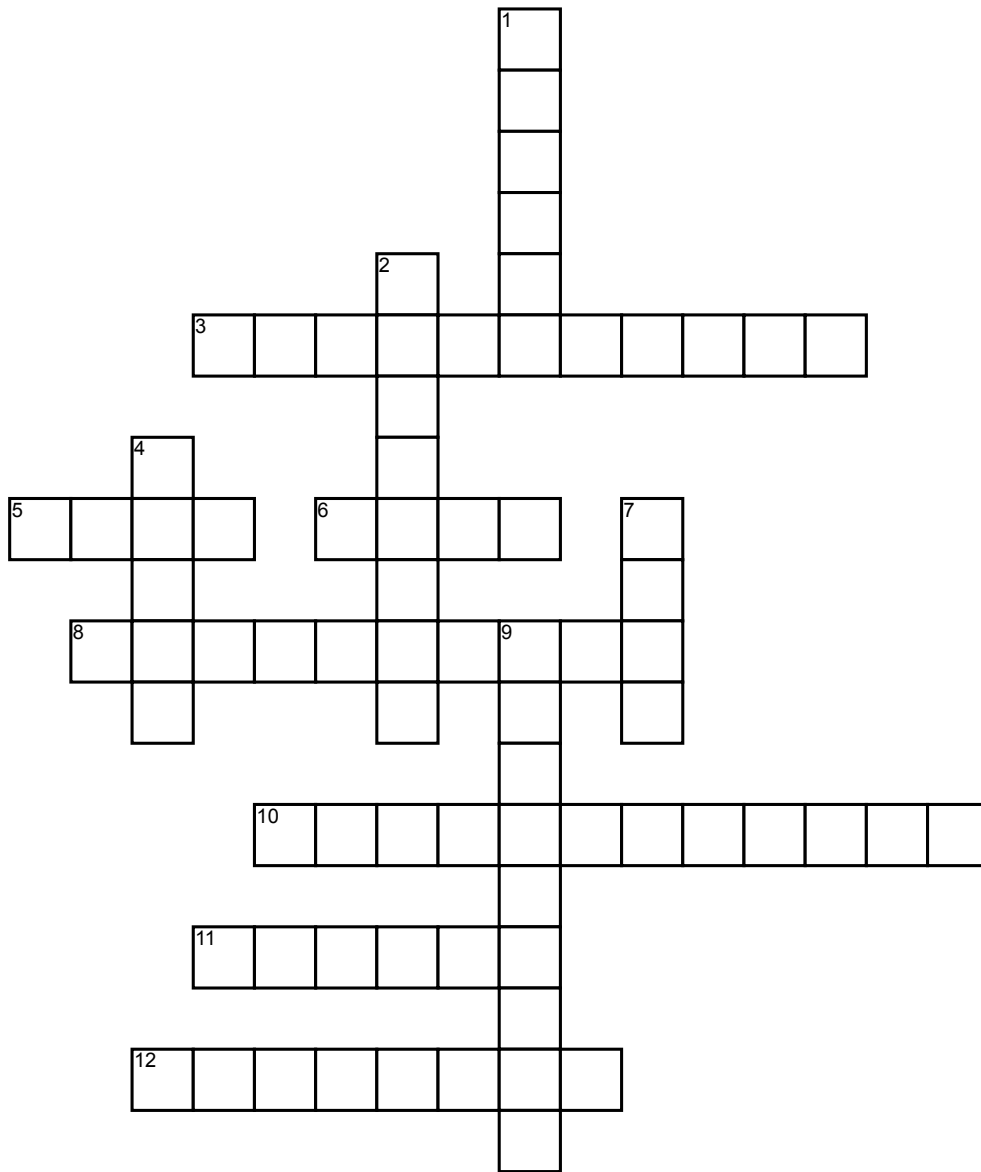


# Medieval Crossword
