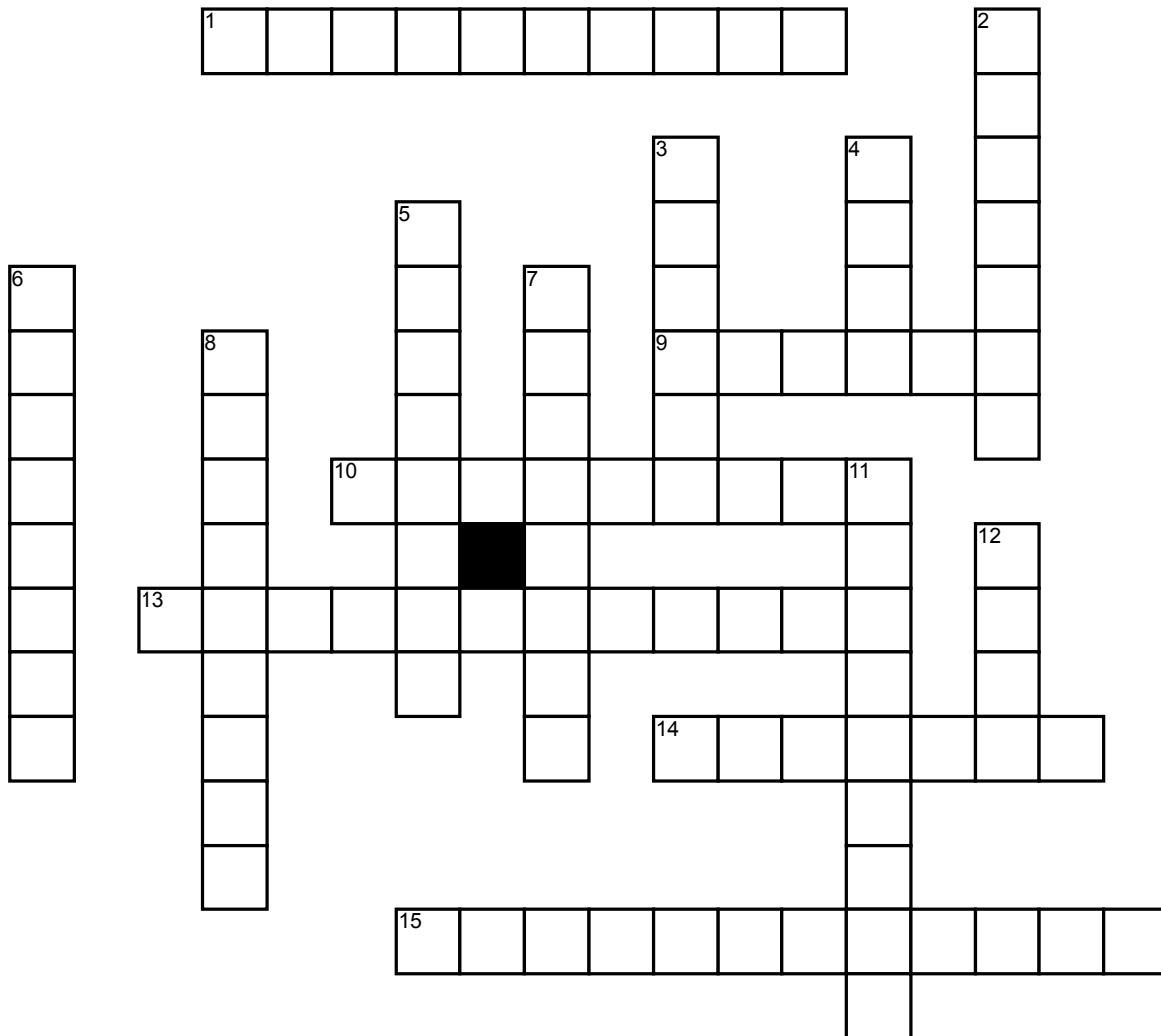


# Medieval religion

**1.** The Sunday before Easter, commemorating Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem.

**9.** The feast of the crucifixion and resurrection of Christ

**10.** A feast celebrating the birth of Christ, held on December 25

**13.** The feast celebrating the visit by the Angel Gabriel to the Virgin Mary to inform her that she was to bear the son of God

**14.** The rite admitting an individual to the Christian church

**15.** Only recognised religion of the Middle Ages.

## **Down**

**2.** The evening service of Divine office, recited before dark

**3.** The preliminary to Christmas, beginning on Sunday closest to November 30

**4.** The 40 days preceding Easter, a period of fasting

**5.** Feast of January 6, associated with the visit of the magi to the infant Jesus

**6.** The annual cycle of church feasts commemorating the life of Christ

**7.** The birth of Christ

**8.** The feast of the ascent of Christ into heaven, celebrated 40 days after Easter

**11.** The annual cycle of services based around the celebration of the feast of the saints

**12.** Must attend every Sunday
