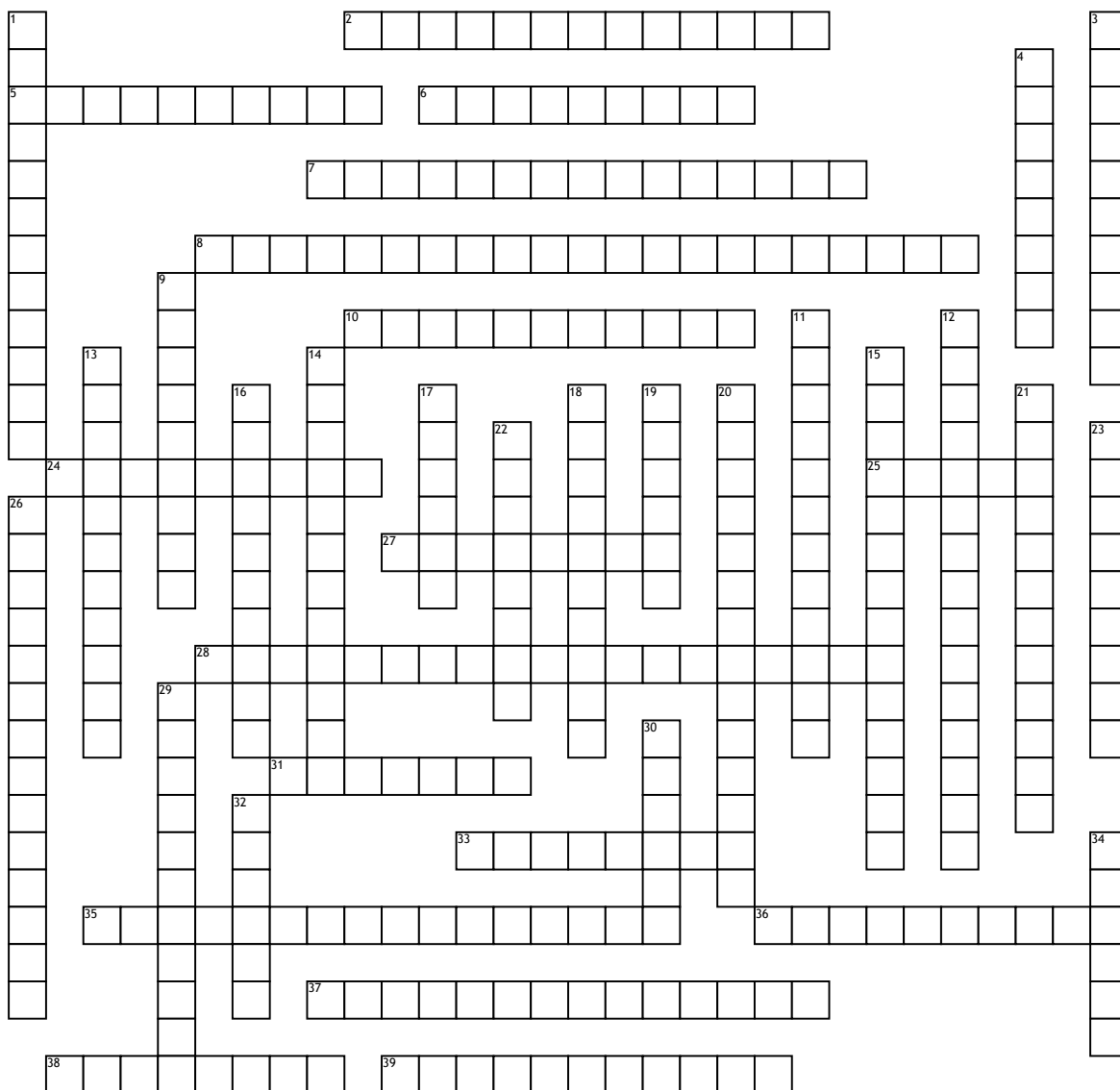


Mid-term crossword puzzle
