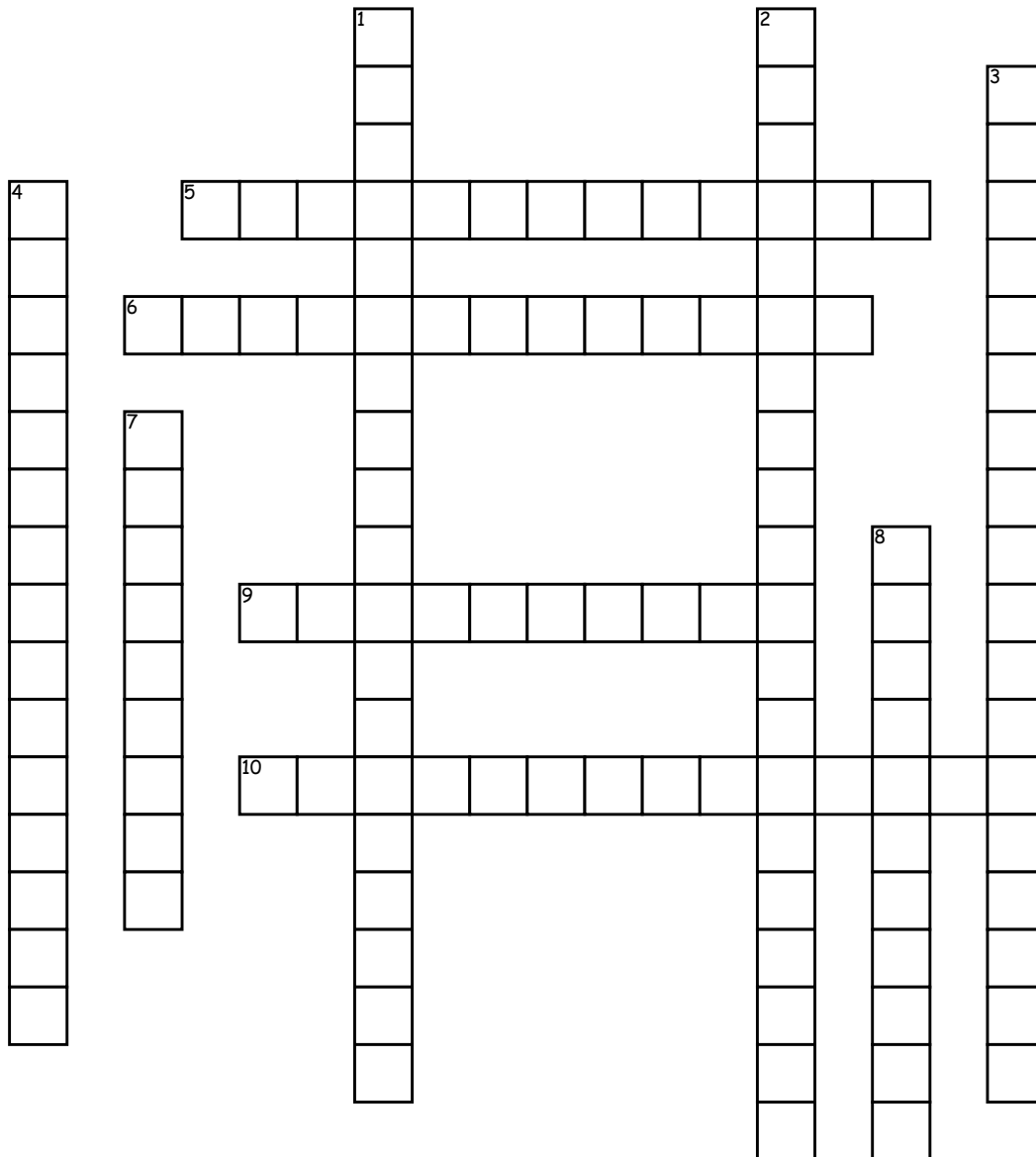

- 5.** An agricultural production system in the South through which wealthy landowners leased individual plots of land on plantations to both whites and blacks in exchange for a percentage of the yearly yield of crops
- 6.** A nickname for northerners who moved to the South after the Civil War, named for their tendency to carry their possessions with them in large carpetbags
- 9.** Laws created by southern states that limited the rights of African Americans
- 10.** Abraham Lincoln's plan for Reconstruction, under which secessionist states could be readmitted to the Union only after 10 percent of their voting population took a loyalty oath to the Union

- 1.** A constitutional amendment, drafted by Radical Republicans in 1866 and ratified in 1868, that ensured that the liberties guaranteed to blacks in the Civil Rights Act Of 1866 could not be taken away
- 2.** A bill that forbade racial discrimination in all public places
- 3.** A constitutional amendment, ratified in 1870, that gave all American men the right to vote, regardless of race or wealth
- 4.** A government agency established by Congress in 1865 to distribute food, supplies, and confiscated land to former slaves
- 7.** White Unionist Republicans in the South who participated in efforts to modernize and transform the region after the Civil War
- 8.** A secret society formed in Tennessee in 1866 to terrorize blacks
