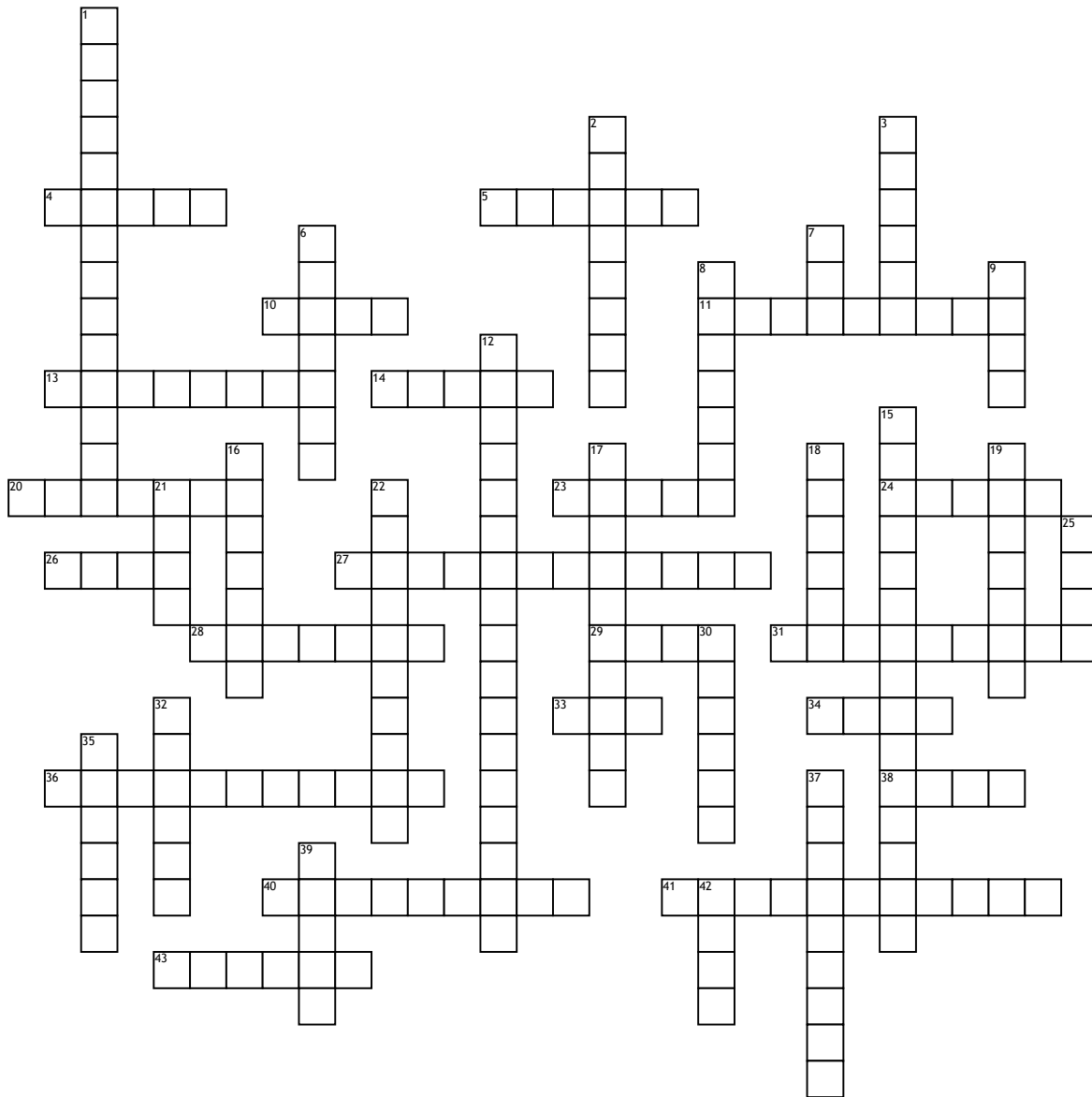

4. Kidney
 5. Perineum
 10. Testis (plural, testes)
 11. Production and release of milk by mammary glands
 13. Mechanical filtering process used to cleanse the blood of toxic substances, such as nitrogenous wastes, when kidneys fail to function properly
 14. Woman, female
 20. Abnormal passage from a hollow organ to the surface or from one organ to another
 23. Ketone bodies (acids and acetones)
 24. Fluid containing sperm and secretions from the prostate and other structures of the male reproductive system
 26. Amnion (amniotic sac)
 27. Removal of the foreskin, or fold of skin covering the tip (glans) of the penis
 28. Prostate gland
 29. Scanty
 31. Prolonged and often painful erection of the penis, which occurs without sexual stimulation
 33. Menses, menstruation
 34. Bladder

36. Acute or chronic inflammation of the prostate

38. Vagina
 40. Removal of all or a segment of the vas deferens for male sterilization
 41. Mineral salt that carries an electrical charge when in solution
 43. Absence of urine production or output

1. Inflammation of the mucous lining of the cervix uteri
 2. Epididymis
 3. Milk
 6. Congenital absence or closure of a normal body opening, such as the vagina
 7. Birth
 8. Albumin, protein
 9. Male
 12. Spontaneous twisting of a testicle within the scrotum, leading to a decrease blood flow to the affected testicle
 15. Incision of the abdomen and uterus to remove the fetus
 16. Bacteria (singular, bacterium)

17. Serous membrane that lines the abdominopelvic cavity and covers most of the organs within the cavity
 18. Ovary
 19. Forming, producing, origin
 21. Urine
 22. Urine screening test that includes physical observation, chemical tests, and microscopic evaluation
 25. Breast
 30. Reproductive cell (ovum or sperm) that contains one-half of the chromosomes required to produce an offspring of the species
 32. Uterus (womb)
 35. Common abnormality of delivery in which the fetal buttocks or feet present first rather than the head
 37. Length of time from conception to birth
 39. Dilated vein
 42. Stone, calculus
