

- **3.** The Moon's continuous orbit around the earth; lasts for one month
- 7. Moon appears darkened as it passes into earths shadow
- **8.** Light increases; left side of the moon is dark
- **10.** Light decreases; right side of the moon is dark
- 12. To light up
- **13.** Force that pulls objects toward the center of the Earth

- **14.** Occurs during the moon's quarter phases; weak tides
- **15.** Moon appears to be more than one- half but not fully illuminated by direct sunlight

Down

- 1. Half of the moon is lit
- **2.** Whole disk of this moon is illuminated, and occurs when in opposition to the sun
- **4.** Moon appears to be partly but less than one- half illuminated by direct sunlight

- **5.** Occurs during full or new moon; strong tides
- **6.** The movement of one object around a center it another object
- **9.** Marks beginning of Lunar Cycle, and illuminated side is facing away from us
- **11.** The changing appearances of the moon as seen from Earth
