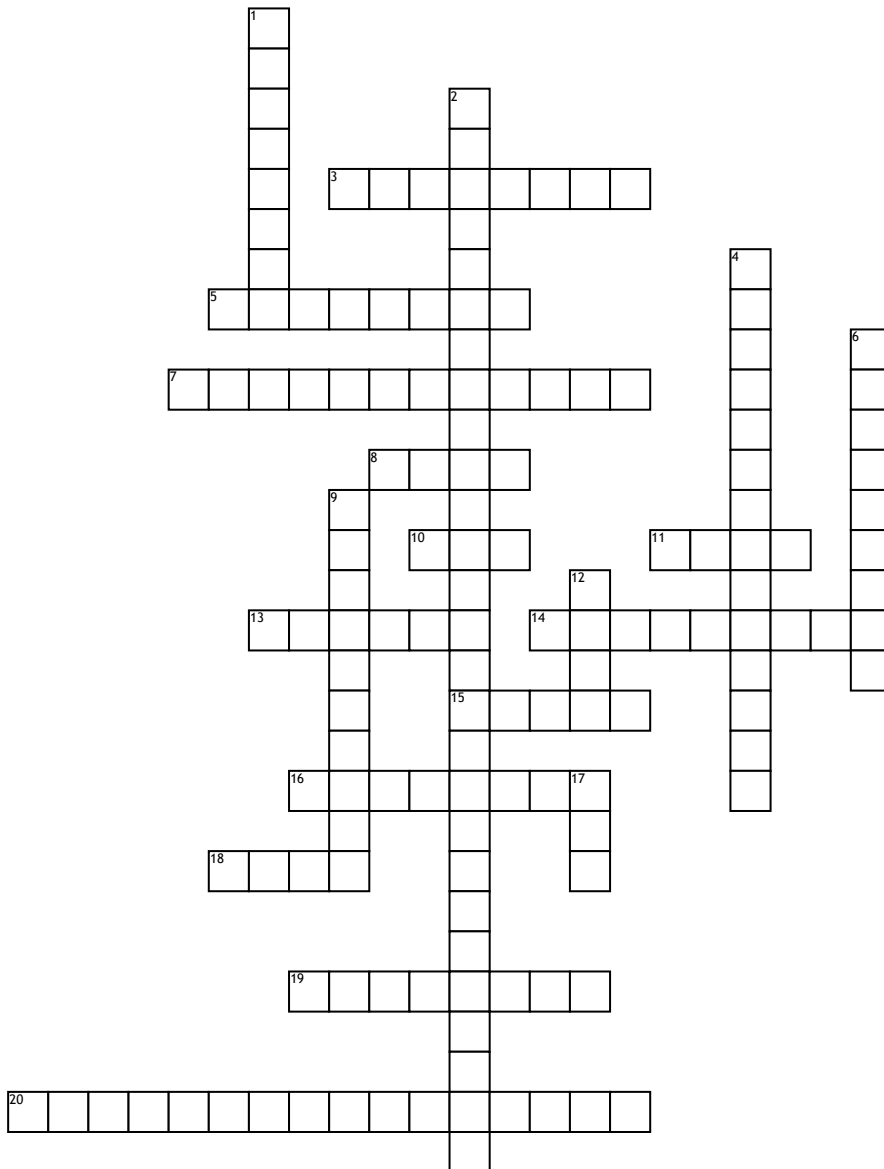


Mountains

3. The top of a very high mountain
 5. Where snow is able to be seen at the top of a mountain
 7. Side of a mountain
 8. A very steep rough part of a mountain
 10. Low area between mountains
 11. Side of a mountain that's very steep and high
 13. A mountain that forms when two or more tectonic plates are pushed together

14. A heavy fall of rocks down the side of a mountain
 15. First layer of the Earth
 16. A mountain that forms when magma erupts and piles on the surface
 18. Very top of a mountain
 19. The level of a mountain which there are no trees
 20. The cause of deformation in the Earth's crust

1. Large landform that rises from the crust and usually in a peak form

2. The lithosphere is divided into two rigid areas called
 4. Pieces of Earth's crust and upper most mantle
 6. A mountain that forms from pressure under Earth's crust pushing upward into a peak
 9. A mountain that's formed by the movement of crustal blocks when forces in the Earth's crust pull it apart
