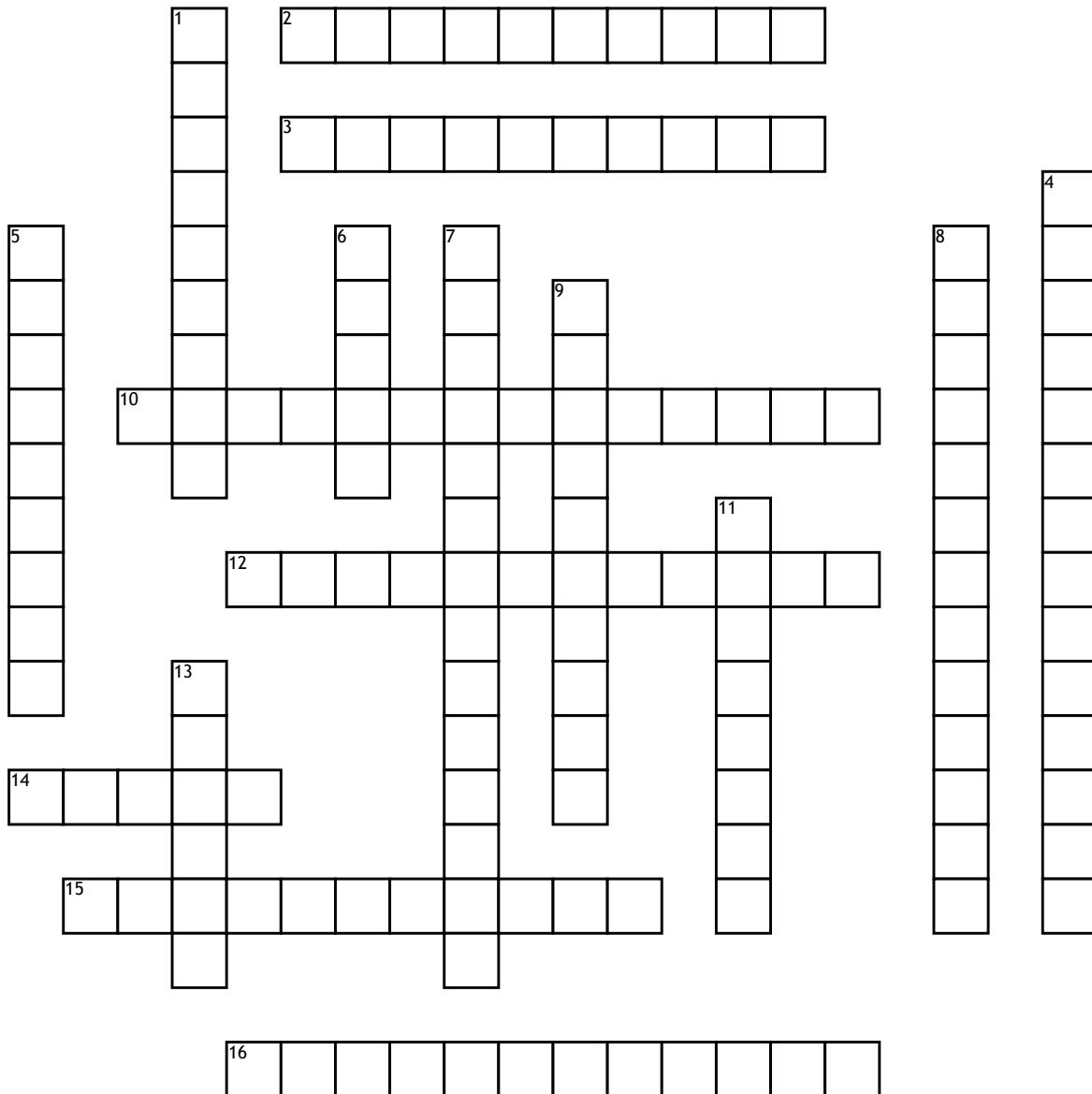

7. A small bundle of muscle

8. Striated and involuntary muscle tissue found only in the heart

9. Dense, hard bone tissue made of tightly packed osteons
11. A band of connective tissue that holds a joint together
13. A type of connective tissue that connects muscle to bone
