
## Muscles & Nerves



## Across

- 4. Muscle that produces the contour of the front & inner side of the upper arm; lifts the forearm & flexes the elbow
- **6.** Large, flat, triangular muscle covering lower back
- ${\bf 8.}$  Tendon that connects the occiptal is & frontalis muscles
- 11. Also known as occipitofrontalis; the broad muscle that covers the top of the skull & consists of occipitalis & frontalis
- 18. Whitish cords
- ${\bf 20.}$  Large muscle that covers the entire back of the upper arm & extends the forearm
- **23.** Branch of the fifth cranial nerve that supplies impulses to the upper part of the face
- **24.** The part of the muscle that does not move; attached closest to the skeleton
- **25.** Sensory-motor nerve that is smaller than the ulnar & radial nerves & supplies the arm & hand
- ${\bf 26.}$  Carries impulses fromm the brain to the muscle or glands

- 27. Front portion of the epicraniu; musle of the scalp that raises the eyebrows, draws the scalp forward, & causes wrinkles across the forehead
- **28.** Muscles that draw a body part, such as a finger, arm, or toe, inward towards the median axis of the body or of an extremity
- **29.** Muscle that seperates the fingers & the toes
- **30.** Ring muscle of the eye socket; enables you to close your eyes

## Down

- 1. Muscles that draw a body part, such as a finger, arm or toe away from the midline of the body or an extremity
- **2.** Also known as efferent nerves; carry impulses from the brain to the muscle or glands
- **3.** the movable part of the muscle that is farthest from the skeleton
- ${\bf 5.}$  Muscle that bends the foot up & extends the toes
- 7. Affects the muscle of the chin, lower lip, & external ear  $\,$

- ${\bf 9.}$  Back portion of the epicranius; muscle that draws the scalp backward
- ${\bf 10.}$  Muscle that elevates the lower lip, raises & wrinkles the skin of the chin
- **12.** Muscle that extends the big toe & flexes the foot
- 13. Muscle that moves the little toe
- **14.** Muscles of the chest that assist the swinging movements of the arm
- **15.** Branch of the seventh cranial nerve thats affects the muscles of the mouth
- **16.** Muscles of the chest assist the swinging movements of the arm
- 17. The middles part of the muscle
- 19. Also known as dorsal cutaneous nerve, a nerve that extends up from the toes & foot, just under the skin, supplying impulses to the toes & foot as well as the muscles & skin of the leg
- **21.** Sensory-motor nerve that supples impulses to the fingers
- **22.** Large, triangular muscle covering the shoulder joint that allows the arm to extend outward & to the side of the body
