

Muscles of the Axial Skeleton



Across

- **3.** Inserts on Anterior part of the iliac crest, rectus sheath to the linea alba External
- **4.** Originates fascia covering the superior part of the pectoralis major
- **5.** Inserts on the medial surface of the ramus of the mandible, articular disc and capsule of temporomandibular joint, and neck of mandible
- 11. Inserts on the angle and ramus of the mandible (Primary muscle used in mastication)
- **16.** inserts on the superior border of the rib below (Originates on the inferior surface of the borders of the ribs above)
- **18.** Originates on the lateral inguinal ligament, iliac crest, and thoracolumbar fascia Internal
- **19.** Small square muscle that originates on the posterior iliac crest Quadratus
- **20.** Muscle Group that Laterally flexes and Extends the spinal column Erector Spinae
- 22. Inserts on the inferior border of the mandible

- **23.** originates on the ligamentum nuchae and the lower spinous processes of the thoracic vertebrae and the upper spinous processes of the lumbar
- **25.** originates in the common tendon and posterior surface of ribs 1-12
- **26.** originates on the sacrum and transverse processes of the lumbar through cervical vertebrae (Ascending)
- **27.** Originates on the pubic crest and pubic symphysis (6 pack muscle.) Rectus

Down

- 1. Originates at the temporal fossa and fascia
- 2. Inserts on the inferior nuchal lines of the occiput and transverse process of the atlas bone (C1)
- **6.** Inserts on the 1st and 2nd ribs (Brachial plexus innervates the arm through here)
- 7. inserts on the Transverse processes of the cervical vertebrae and the mastoid process of the temporal bone
- 8. Originals on the galea apponeurotica

- **9.** Originates on the top of the manubrium and medial one third of the clavicle
- 10. Originates on the inner surface of the lower six ribs, upper two or three lumbar vertebrae, and inner part of the xiphoid process
- 12. inserts on the spinous processes of the lumbar vertebrae through the second cervical vertebrae
- 13. Originates on the lateral inguinal ligament, iliac crest, thoracolumbar fascia, and internal surface of lower six ribs (hour glass muscle)
- **14.** Originates on the top of the manubrium, thyroid cartilage, and the superior border of the scapula
- 15. Inserts on the hyoid bone
- **17.** Originates on the bodies of the C5-T3 and the transverse processes of C3 trough C5
- **21.** Inserts on the transverse processes of the C1-C3 Splenius
- 24. Originates on the inferior one half of the ligamentum nuchae and the spinous processes of C7-T4 Splenius
