

- **5.** The amount of oxygen required after physical excersise to convert accumulated lactic acid to glucose
- **6.** An enzyme that catalyzes breakdown of Acetlycholine
- **9.** The functional connection between the axon of a neuron and the dendrite or cell body of another neuron or the membrane of another cell type
- **10.** Muscle responsible for a body movement. Also called a prime mover
