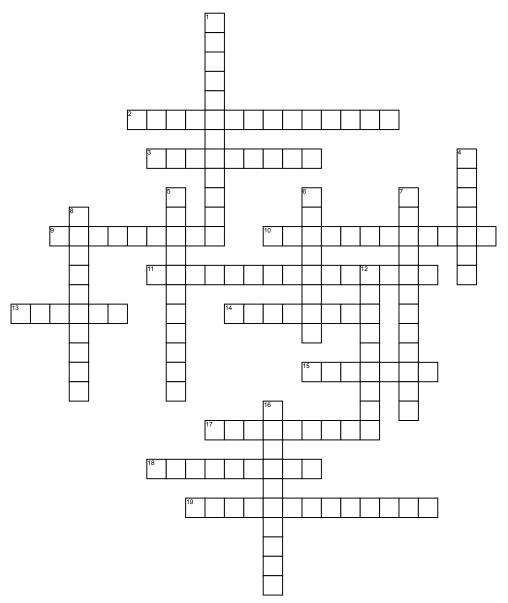
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Musculoskeletal Crossword Puzzle

- **2.** Flexing the arch of the foot by pointing the toes downward
- **3.** Rotation of the palm so that it is facing down or backwards
- **9.** Painful inflammation and stiffness of the joints
- **10.** A loss of bone tissue making bones weak and brittle
- **11.** Muscle located on the lateral side of the thigh, the largest of the quadriceps and preferred area for shots in infants
- **13.** Fracture where the bone does not stick through the skin

- **14.** Fracture where there is a break in the skin near the broken bone
- **15.** A rounded, triangular muscle located on the uppermost part of the arm and the top of the shoulder
- **17.** Moving a body part toward the midline of the body
- **18.** Straightening of the joint
- **19.** An injection delivered into the muscle

Down

- **1.** An injection administered in the fat layer underneath the skin
- 4. Bending of the joint

- **5.** Injection delivered into the dermis (a few mm thick) of the skin layer underneath the epidermis
- **6.** Twisting or turning of a joint
- 7. Bending the foot upward at the ankle by pulling the toes towards the head
- **8.** A fracture of the bone, occurring typically in children, in which one side of the bone is broken and the other only bent
- **12.** Moving a body part away from the midline of the body
- **16.** Rotation of the palm so that it is facing up or forward
