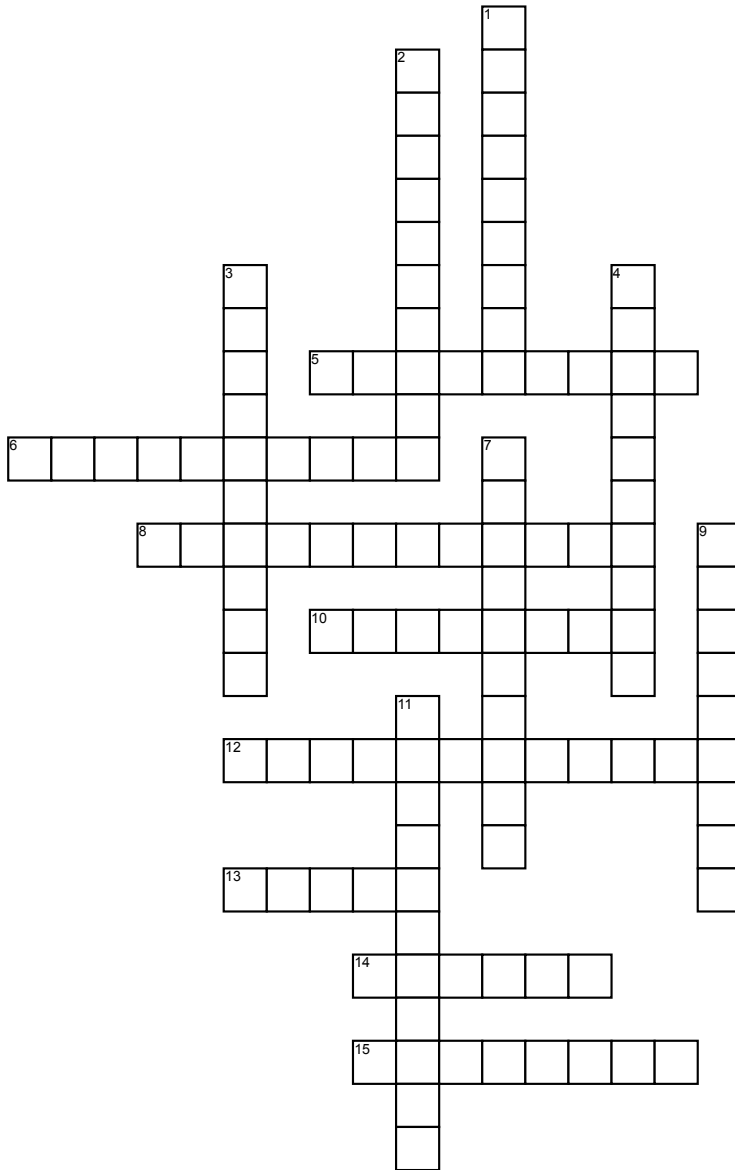


# Musculoskeletal System

15. Flexible bands of tissue that are highly adapted for resisting strains

- 1. moves away from the midline
- 2. General term for bone disease
- 3. Covers surface of bone not covered by articular cartilage
- 4. very large, irregularly shaped process found only on the femur
