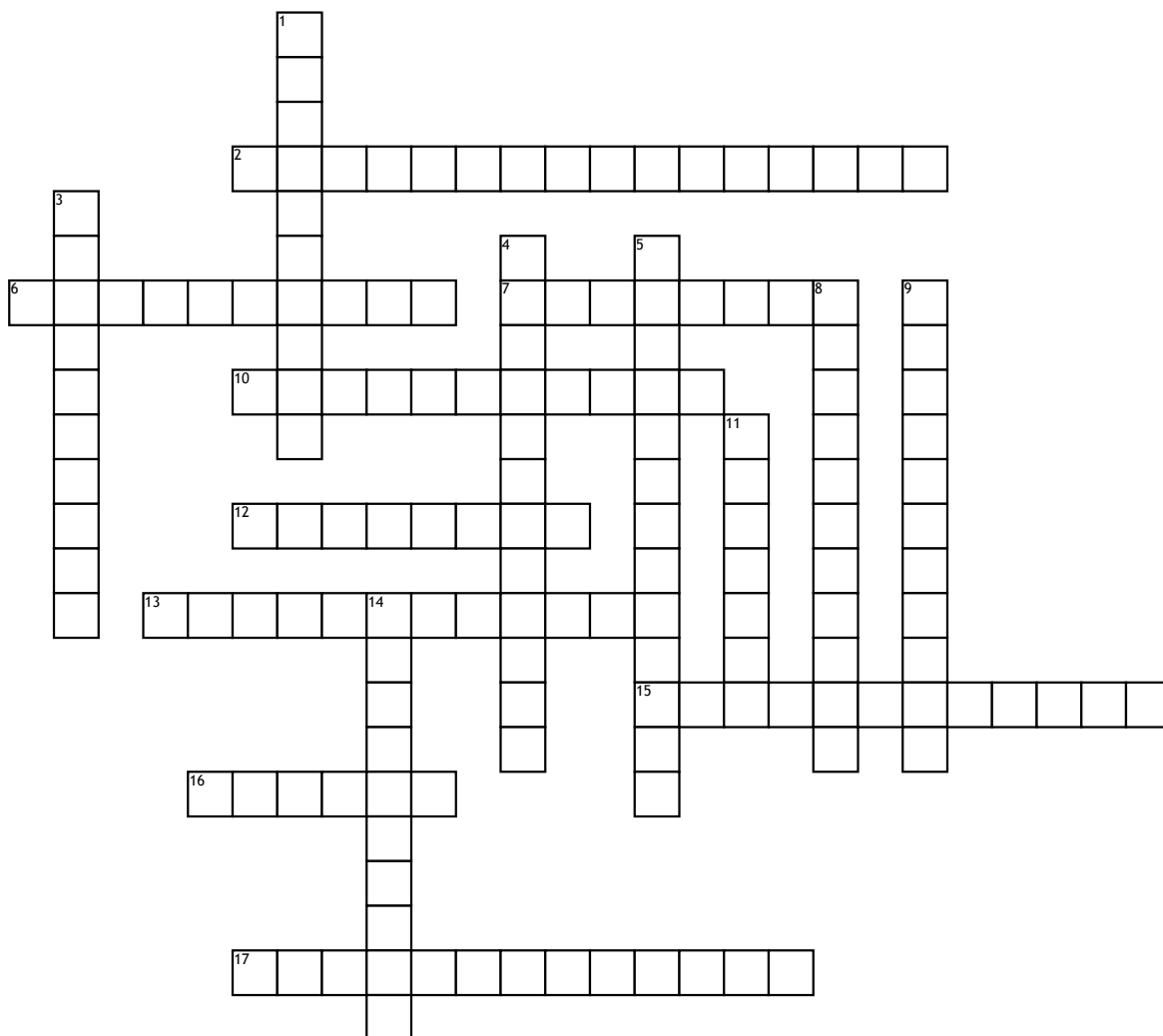

2. A major third in the final chord of a piece in a minor key
 6. A musical form for arias. Its sung by a soloist accompaniment of instruments.
 7. Musical flourishes. Normally added notes
 10. A bassline with intended harmonies indicated by figures.
 12. Sets one note to each syllable of text
 13. A grace note that delays the next note of the melody.

15. A word phrase or sound used to convey an emotion such as surprise, excitement, happiness, or anger.

16. A passionate expression of grief.

17. Meaning "continuous bass".

1. A single syllable of text is sung, carried through many notes. (A style of singing).
 3. An extra note added as an embellishment
 4. Reflects the literal meaning of a song's lyrics

5. A type of dissonance that sometimes occurs in polyphonic music.

8. Opening section, Second section, repeat of first section.

9. Play a chord as a series of ascending or descending notes.

11. A rapid alternation of a note with the note immediately below or above it in the scale.

14. Constantly repeated in the bass section
