
## Music Terminology and Stylistic Markings



## <u>Across</u>

- 2. Very quiet
- 4. Loud
- **8.** A stress or special emphasis on a beat, sharp attack that can be used at any dynamic level from pianissimo to fortissimo
- **10.** A smooth, graceful, connected style. Often indicated by a slur over the effected notes.
- 11. Gradually getting louder
- **12.** Marked, emphatic, stressed, strongly emphasize the note, putting power into it
- Down 1. Quiet
- 3. Moderately quiet

- 5. Gradually getting softer
- **6.** Medium loud, normal volume
- 7. Very loud
- **9.** A style of playing notes in a detached, separated, distinct manner, as opposed to legato. Indicated by a dot directly above or below the note head.
