

- 17. To play medium loud

- **3.** Tells the number of beats in a measure
- 5. To gradually get louder

- 9. To play soft

- 21. Play the note 1/2 step higher
- **24.** Play that note with extra stress/emphasis
- **25.** Cancels out any sharp or flat signs
