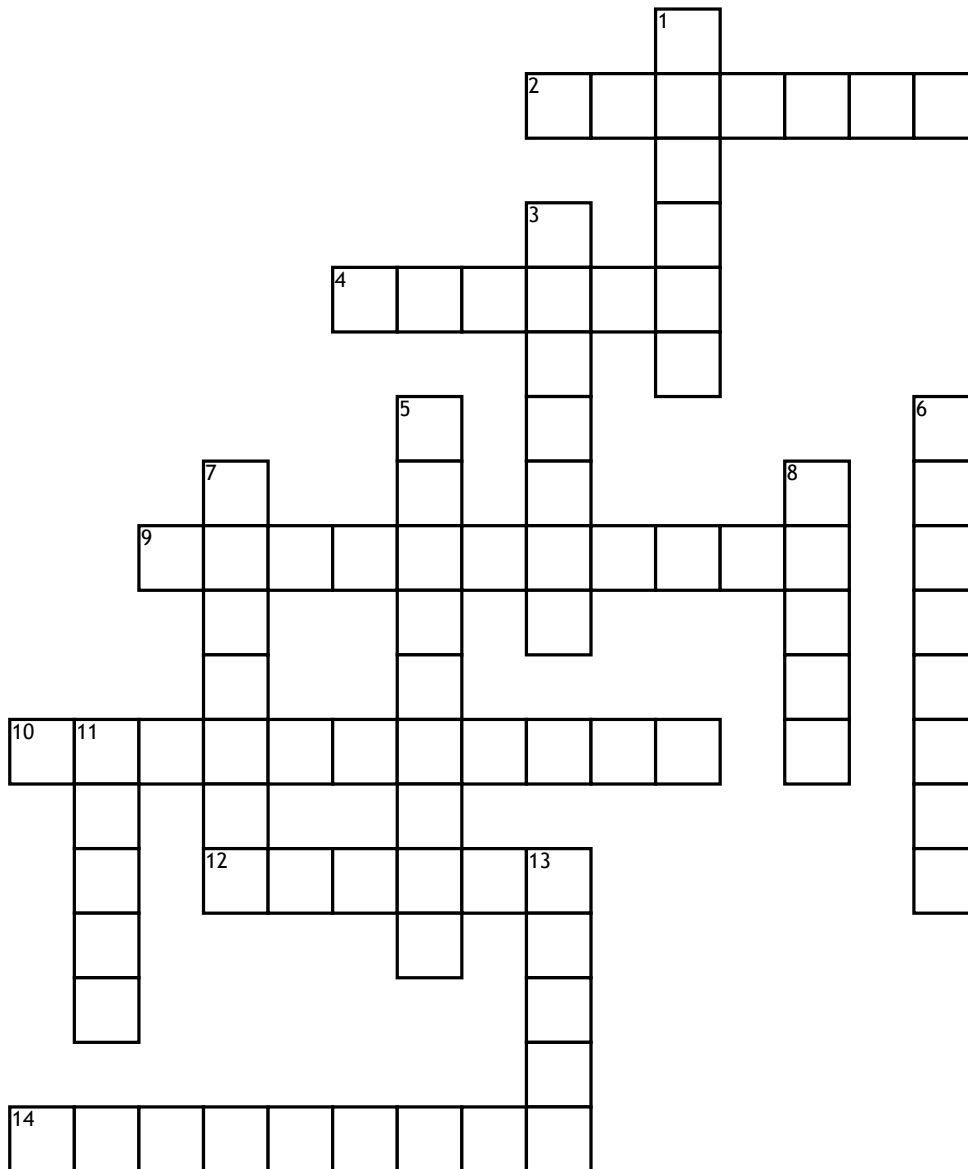


Musical Crossword
