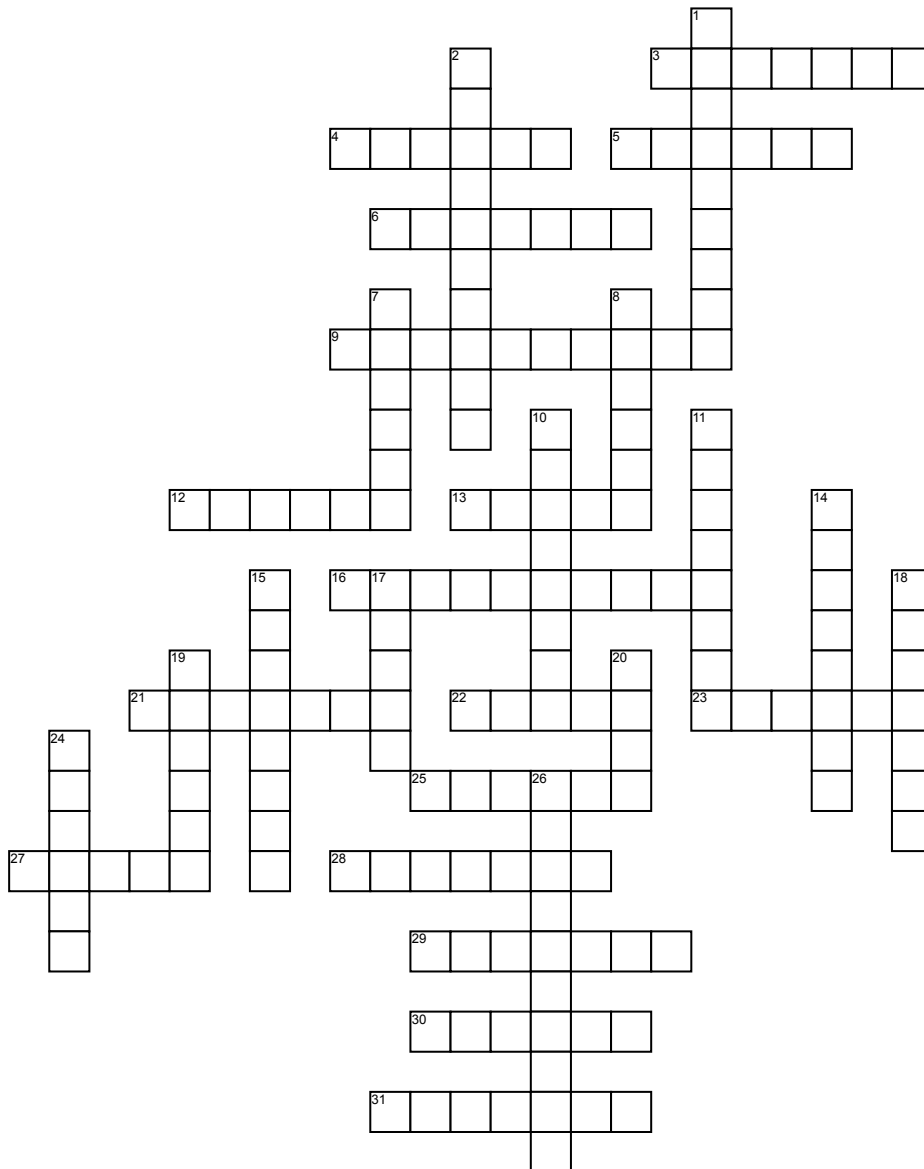

 28. First woman created by the gods; name means "all gifted"  
 29. Mythical family of giants with one eye in center of forehead  
 30. Roman god of fire and metal working; Hephaestus in Greek mythology

 2. One of the Cyclops; stabbed in the eye by Odysseus  
 7. 3 sister goddesses who confer grace, beauty, and charm upon nature

8. Greek god of the winds  
 10. Monster in Greek mythology; half man, half bull  
 11. Greek warrior whose legend is the subject of Homer's Odyssey  
 14. Legendary artist and inventor  
 15. Greek god of the sea  
 17. Legendary king of Troy; killed in the Trojan war  
 18. Daughter of King Minos; helped Theseus escape from labyrinth
