
## NATURAL DISASTERS



## <u>Across</u>

- **2.** A long, high sea wave caused by an earthquake or other disturbances
- 4. A long period when there is little or no rain
- 8. A prolonged period of abnormally hot weather
- **10.** A mass of rock and earth moving suddenly and quickly down a steep slope
- **11.** A strong, dangerous wind that forms itself into an upside-down spinning cone and is able to destroy buildings as it moves across the ground

## <u>Down</u>

- **1.** A sudden violent shaking of the ground caused by movements within the earth's crust or volcanic action
- **3.** A flash of bright light in the sky that is produced by electricity moving between clouds or from clouds to the ground
- **5.** A mass of snow, ice and rocks falling rapidly down a mountainside
- A very strong wind
- **7.** To cause to fill or become covered with water, especially in a way that causes problems:
- **9.** The noise heard after a lightning flash
