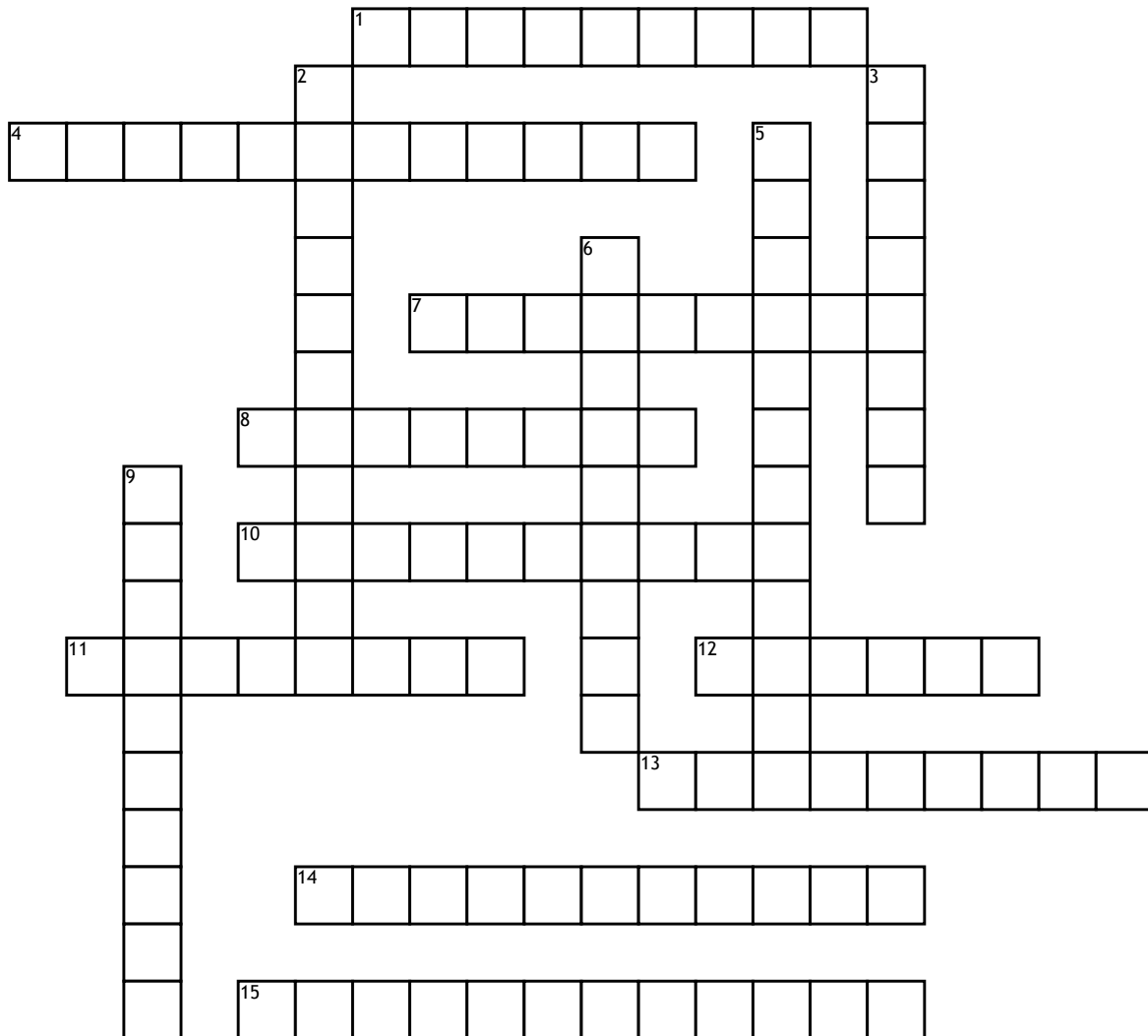

1. mass of hard, dry stool that will not pass out of the colon or rectum
4. difficulty passing stool, usually because it's hard and dry
7. colon resection where two ends of the colon are reattached
8. frequent passing of watery, liquid, or loose stools

10. full bladder, often uncomfortable

11. the earliest stool of an infant
12. absence of urine
13. diversion of the small intestines through a stoma in the skin
14. swollen veins in the lowest part of the rectum and anus
15. presence of stones called calculi in the urinary tract

3. used for the treatment of acute or chronic kidney failure
5. loss of control of either bowel or bladder elimination
6. Either incomplete emptying of the bladder after urination or complete inability to urinate
