

- **8.** A condition in which the living skin around the nail plate splits or tears
- **9.** Sometimes called furrows; visible depressions running across the natural nail plate
- **10.** Nails that turn a variety of colors, which may indicate surface staining, systemic disorder, or poor blood circulation

- **2.** A servere inflammation of the nail in which a lump of red tissue grows up from the nail bed to the nail plate

- **4.** Fungal infection of the feet also known as athlete's foot
- 5. Darkening of the fingernails or toenails
- **6.** A condition that affects the surface of the natural nail plate causing tiny pits or severe roughness on the surface of the nail plate
