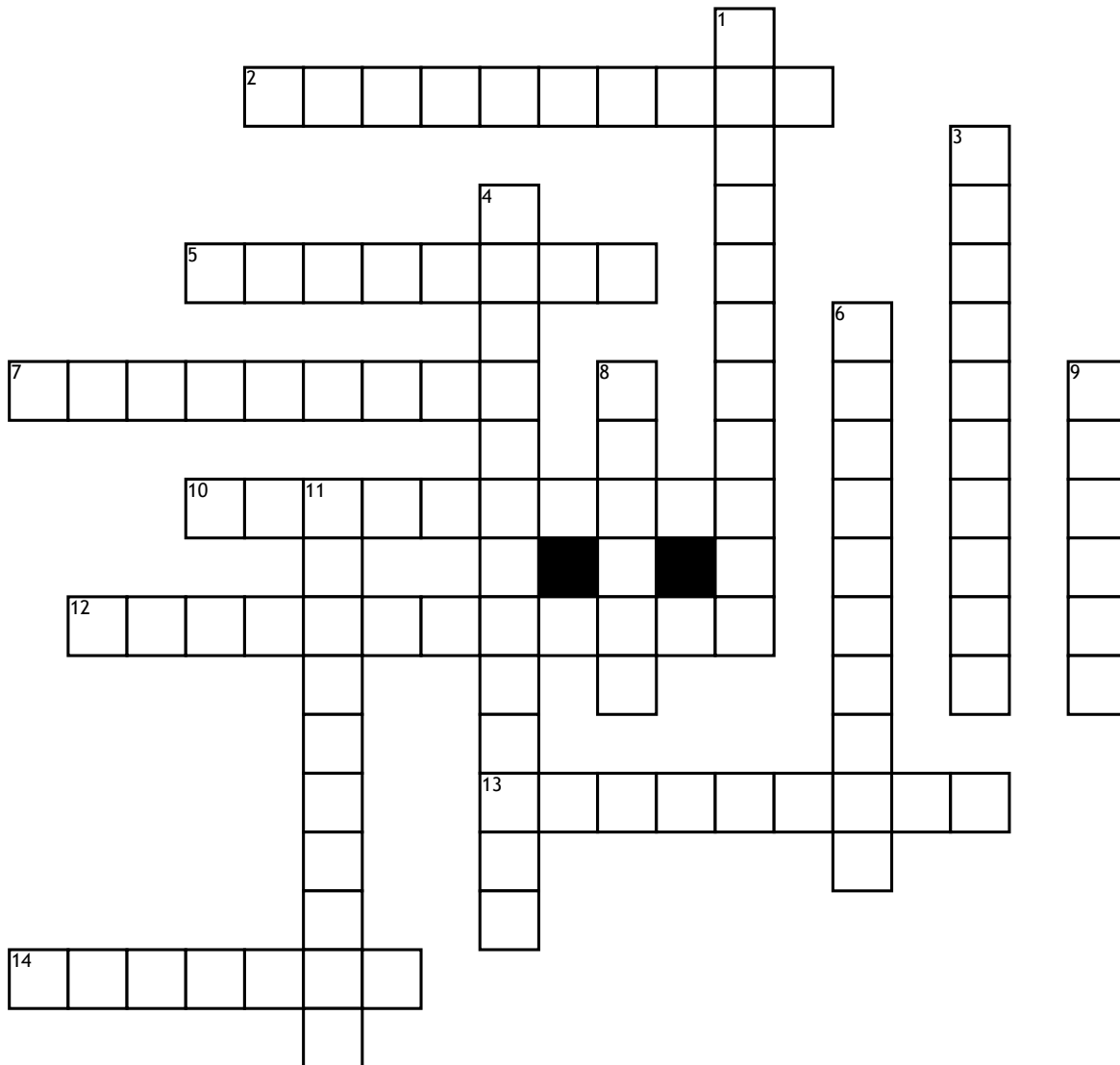


Nancy word puzzle
