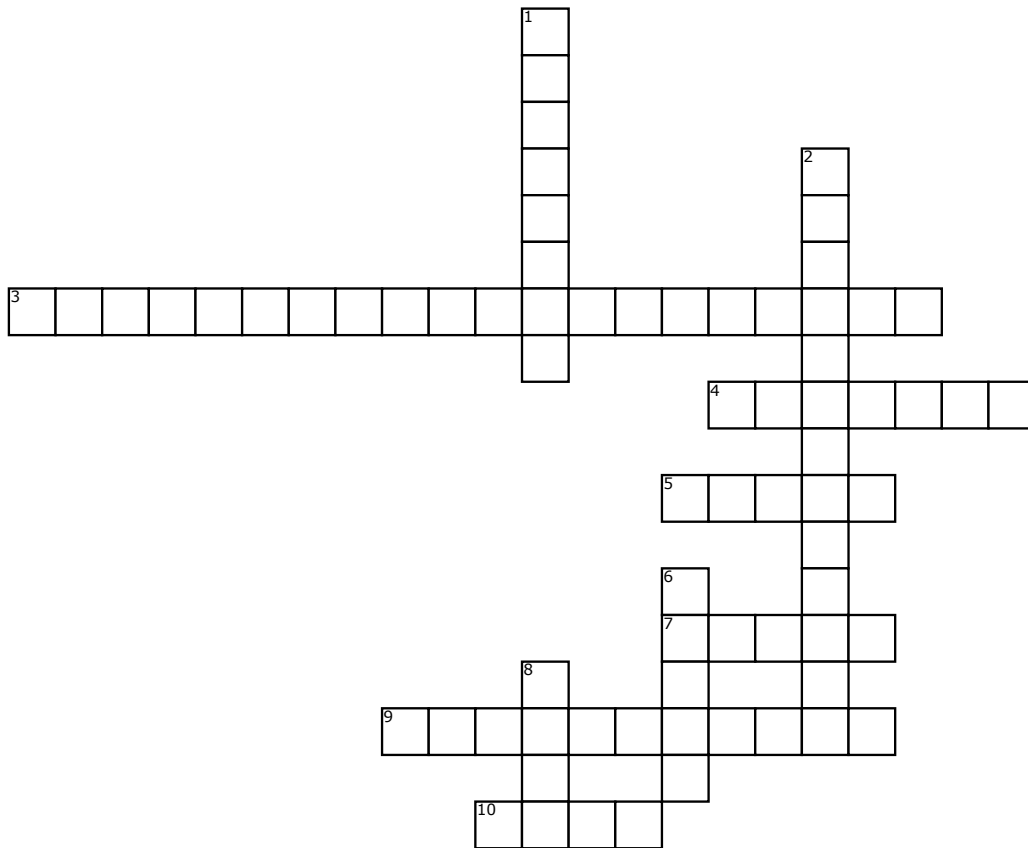


# Nasogastric Tubes
