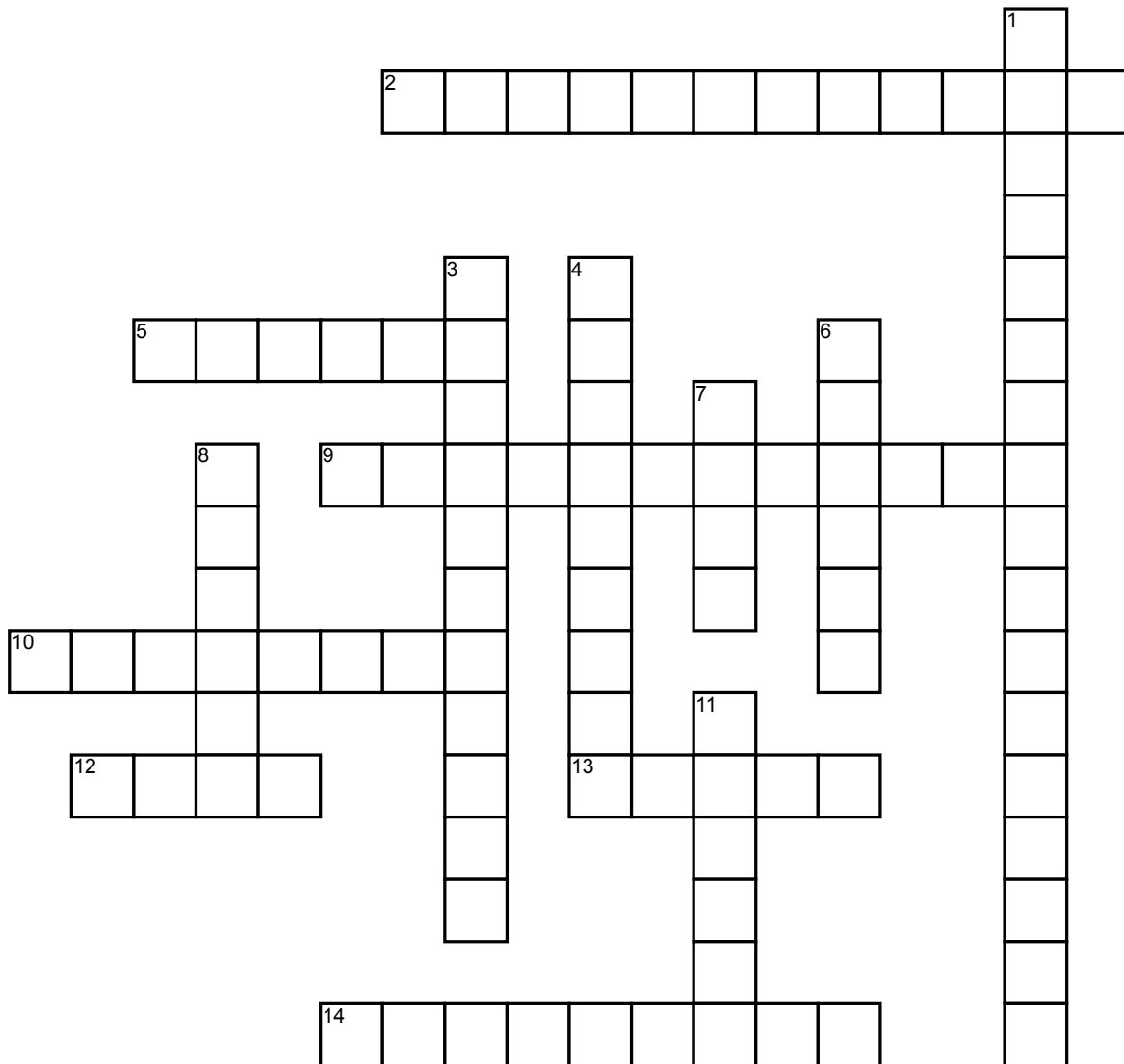


# Native Tribes of Texas
