

4. A mobile, vortex, violent blast of wind.6. a type of tropical cyclone, which is a generic term for a low pressure system that generally forms in the tropics.

8. a large mass of snow, ice, earth, rock, or other material in swift motion down a mountainside or over a precipice.

9. The layer of the earth between the crust and the outer core

10. Small sections of earth that float and travel around over the mantle

11. A long, high sea wave caused by an earthquake or other disturbance.

1. A sudden, violent shaking of the ground, usually caused by the earths crust or volcanic action.

a large scale air mass that rotates around a strong center of low atmospheric pressure.
a prolonged period of excessively hot weather, which may be accompanied by high humidity, especially in oceanic climate countries
The earths innermost layer, that makes up 70% of the earths radius.
