

- **2.** abnormal electrical activity that occurs in one or more parts of the brain hemisphere; partial seizure
- **3.** unilateral (one-sided) paralysis of the nerves that control the facial muscle
- **10.** paralysis of one side of the body
- 11. diffuse pain (that is, pain that is spread out) in one or more parts of the head
- 13. tumor of the neuroglial (glial)
- **15.** A traumatic brain injury resulting from a blow to the head or violent shaking of the head and upper body **16.** a subjective sensation that often
- occurs before a migraine or seizure

 17. a Temporary loss of consciousness
 due to inadequate blood flow to the brain

- **18.** a rare but serious condition that results in acute encephalopathy (brain malfunction) and hepatomegaly (liver enlargement); typically seen in children under 18 years of age after a viral infection
- **19.** progressive disorder of the nervous system marked by signs such as tremor **20.** an epileptic seizure characterized by violent muscle contractions and loss of consciousness; tonic-clonic seizure.

- 1. sensation of numbness, pickling, or tingling, usually in upper or lower extremities
- **4.** lack of awareness of oneself and the inability to respond to environmental stimuli due to injury, shock, or oxygen deprivation

- **5.** abnormal, localized (limited to one area) dilation of blood vessel in the cerebrum
- **6.** any intracranial mass, which may be neoplaic (a growth), cystic (a sac containing fluid), or inflammatory (an abscess)
- 7. temporary or permanent loss of voluntary movement (motor function)
- **8.** A condition of progressive mental deterioration caused by organic brain diease
- **9.** an involuntary, repetitive trembling of the body or limbs
- **12.** inflammation of the gray matter of spinal cord; caused by a highly contagious virus
- 14. split spine
