
Nervous System

- **2.** Subdivision of the nervous system that brings information to the CNS from the body
- **5.** Part of the brain which assists in coordination and balance
- **8.** Carries neural messages from the cell body of a neuron down to its terminals
- **11.** Part of the neuron which first picks up a message from the previous neuron
- **12.** Subdivision of the PNS that controls voluntary activities such as the movement of muscles:

- **13.** Nervous system subdivision that is composed of the brain and spinal cord:
- **14.** A chemical messenger that travels across the synapse from one neuron to the next
- **15.** Lobe of the brain responsible for vision
- **16.** Connects the two hemispheres of the brain
- **17.** Lobe of the brain responsible for hearing

1. Junction or gap between neurons.

- **3.** Part of the autonomic nervous system responsible for our 'fight-flight' response
- **4.** Cells that transmit electrical message from one area of the body to another area
- **6.** White, fatty material that covers long nerve fibers, protecting and insulating the axon
- **7.** Lobe of the brain responsible for spatial awareness
- **9.** Cortex located in the parietal lobe
- **10.** Lobe of the brain responsible for decision making and emotional control
