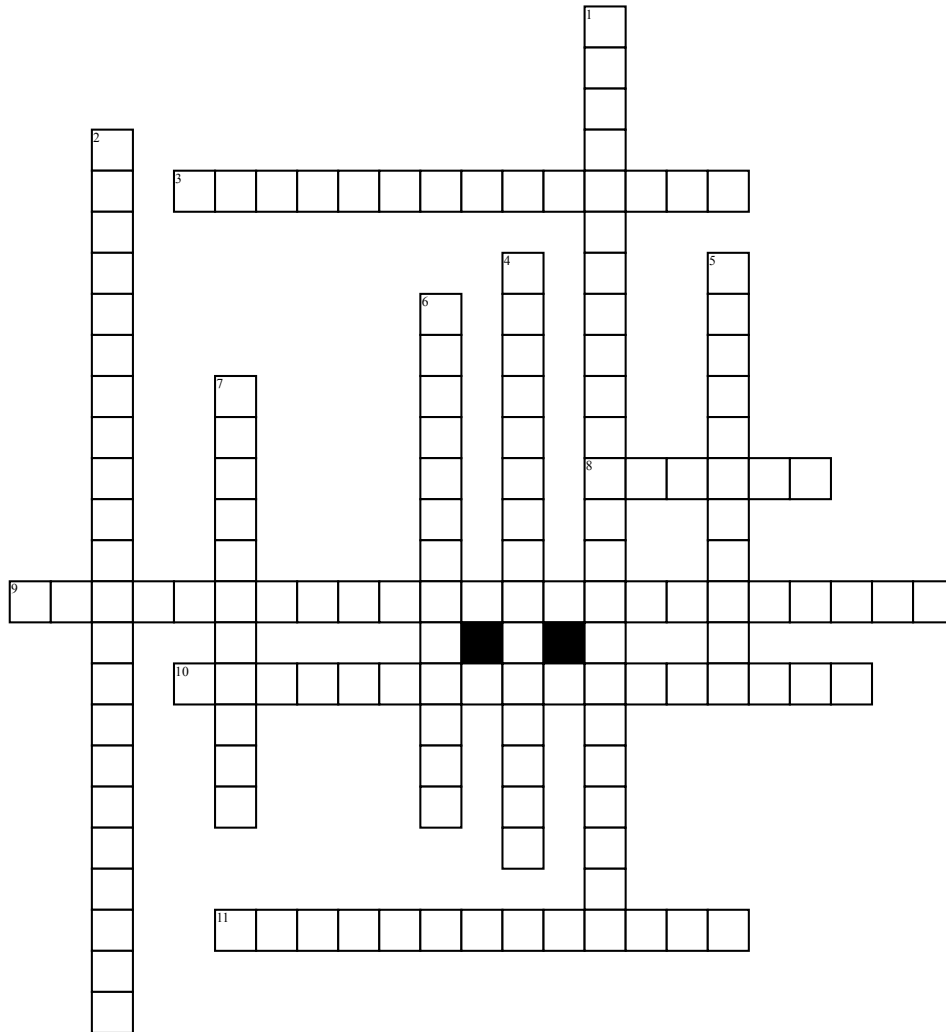


Nervous System Crossword

3. Affects the muscles of the upper part of the cheek.
 8. An automatic reaction to a stimulus that involves the movement of an impulse from a sensory receptor along the sensory nerve to the spinal cord.
 9. Affects muscles of the chin & upper lip.
 10. Known as anterior tibial nerves. Extends down the front legs, behind the muscles. Supplies impulses to these muscles and also to muscles and skin on top of foot and toes.
 11. Affects the muscles of the temple, side of the forehead, eyebrow, eyelid, and upper part of the cheek.

1. Affects the muscles behind the ear at the base of the skull.

2. Also known as the facial nerve. The chief motor nerve of the face. Divides and branches supply and control all muscles of facial expression.
 4. Supplies impulses to the skin of the forehead, upper eyelids, and interior portion of the scalp, orbit, eyeball, & nasal passage.
 5. Affects muscles of the mouth
 6. Also known as afferent nerves. Carries impulses or messages from the sense organs to the brain where the 5 senses are experienced.
 7. Sensory motor nerve that is smaller than the ulnar and radial nerves and that with its branches, supplies the arm and hand.
