
Neurones and nervous coordination

- **8.** produces chemical that are transported in the blood plasma to their target cells

- **10.** covers the axon, made of Schwann cells

- **11.** impulses from intermediate to an effector
- **12.** constrictions between adjacent Schwann cells

<u>Down</u>

- 1. impulses from carrying receptors to intermediate changes
- 2. a cell body, dendrons, axon, Schwann cells

- **3.** stimulated target cells which secrete chemicals
- **4.** extensions of the cell body
- **5.** specialised cells adapted to rapidly carrying electrochemical changes
- 6. surround the axon
