

2. Fifth book of the New Testament, a valuable history of the early Christian church.
4. It was sent by Paul the Apostle and Sosthenes from Ephesus to the church in Corinth.
5. The theme of the epistle is the doctrine of the person of Christ and his role as mediator between God and humanity.
6. A letter written by St. Paul to the Christians of Colossae and included as a book in the New Testament.
