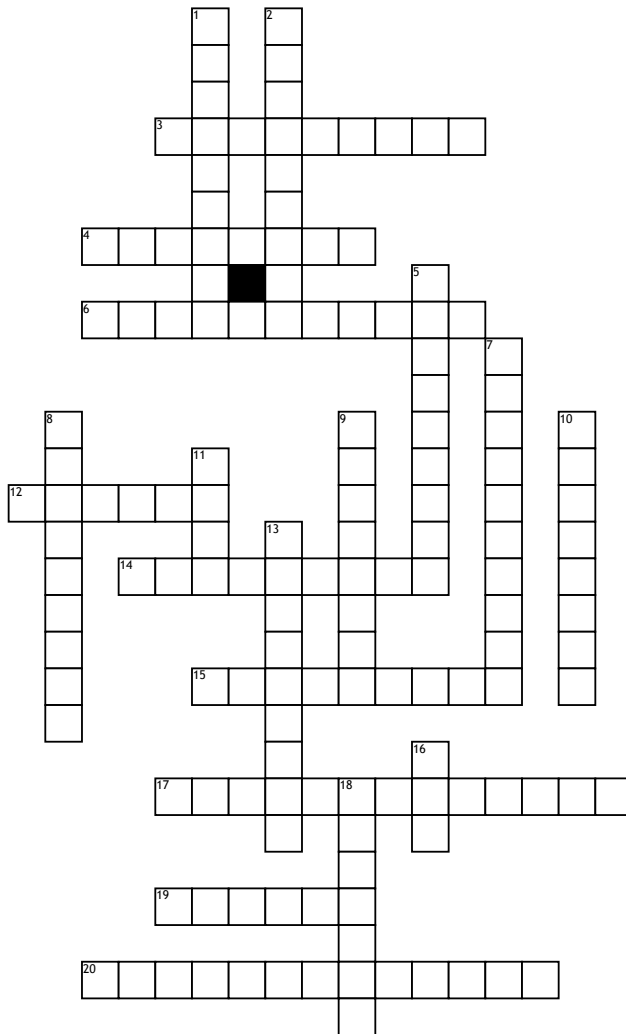


Number the Stars Crossword Puzzle
