

- **2.** An underground holding tank, used for anaerobic decomposition of waste water sewage which is collected upstream of the drain field in a septic system.
- **3.** Distance in inches that sleeves must extend on either side of area of conflict.
- **5.** Horizontal clearance in feet for high pressure or transmission pipelines.
- 7. A pipe, tubing, or channel of various materials, through which something (fluid, gas, cables or conductors) which are conveyed or protected.
- **9.** Fiberglass Reinforced Plastic provides mechanical strength, resistance to damage.

- 1. Also called leach fields are subsurface wastewater disposal systems used to remove contaminants from liquid after anaerobic processing in a septic tank.
