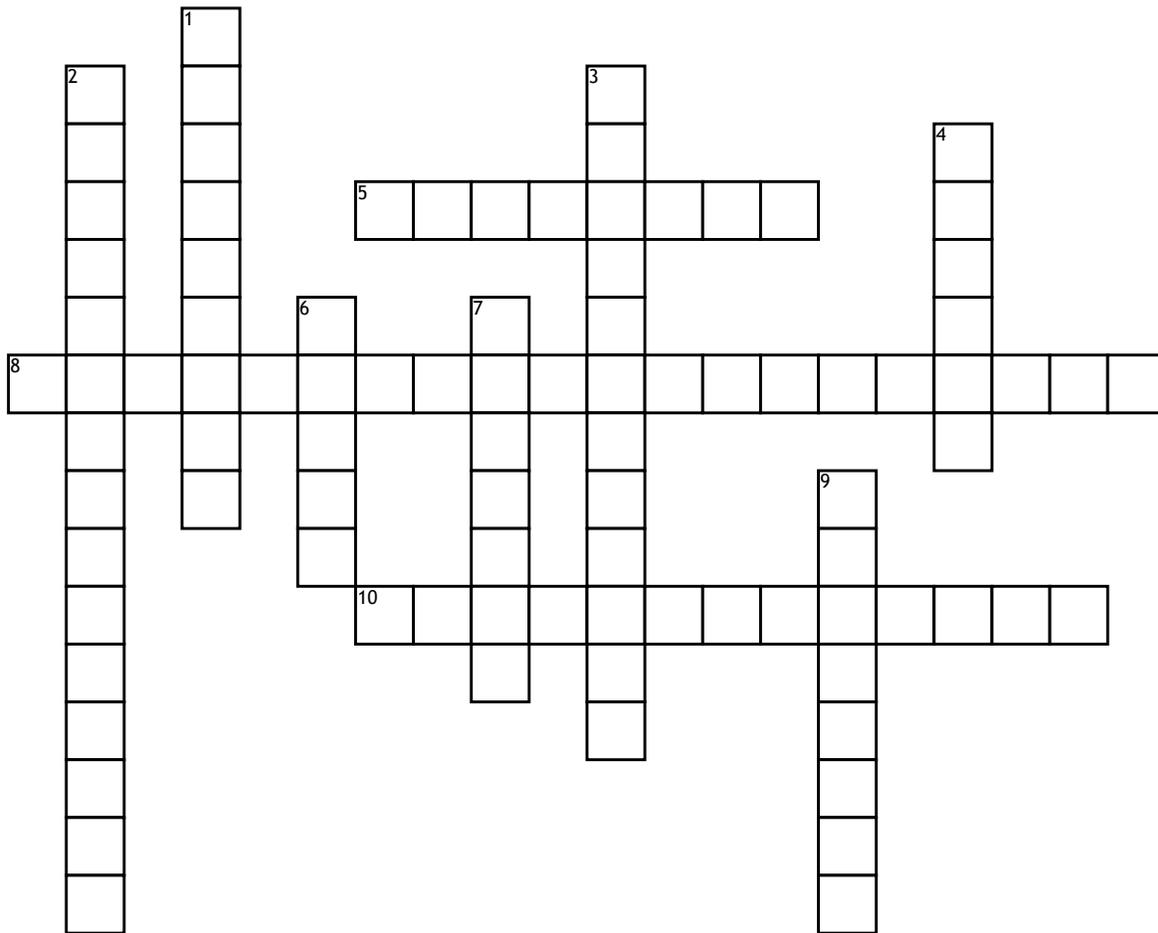

1. General term including physical, mental, and social aspects, that make up what can be called a 'good life'

2. Unique features of the person reflecting the particular background of their life and living that are not part of a health condition or health state

3. Deep experience of meaning brought about by engaging in occupations that involve the enacting of personal values and beliefs, reflection, and intention within a supportive contextual environment"

4. specific, automatic adaptive or maladaptive behaviors, which may be healthy or unhealthy

6. an aspect of occupational identity—that is, they help define who a person, group, or population believes themselves to be on the basis of their occupational history and desires for the future

7. Nonobligatory activity that is intrinsically motivated and engaged in during discretionary time, that is, time not committed to obligatory occupations such as work, self-care, or sleep

9. Effective and efficient response by the client to occupational and contextual demands
