

- **20.** Sympathetic nerve paralysis with protrusion of the third eyelid, miosis, ptosis and enophthalmos
- 21. Pus in the anterior chamber

**26.** The protrusion of the eyeball

- **27.** Abnormally shaped pupil
- **28.** The removal of the eyeball and the soft tissues in the orbit

- **1.** Modified sebaceous glands in the eyelids
- **2.** The overflow of tears due to blockage of the lacrimal duct system
- **4.** Inflammation of the inner structures of the eye
- **5.** Inflammation of the superficial tissue of the sclera
- 6. Removal of the eyeball
- 8. Increased intraocular pressure
- **10.** The junction of the palpebral and bulbar conjunctiva

- **12.** infection of the Meibomian (Tarsal) gland
- **13.** The removal of the contents of the eye with retention of the cornea and the sclera
