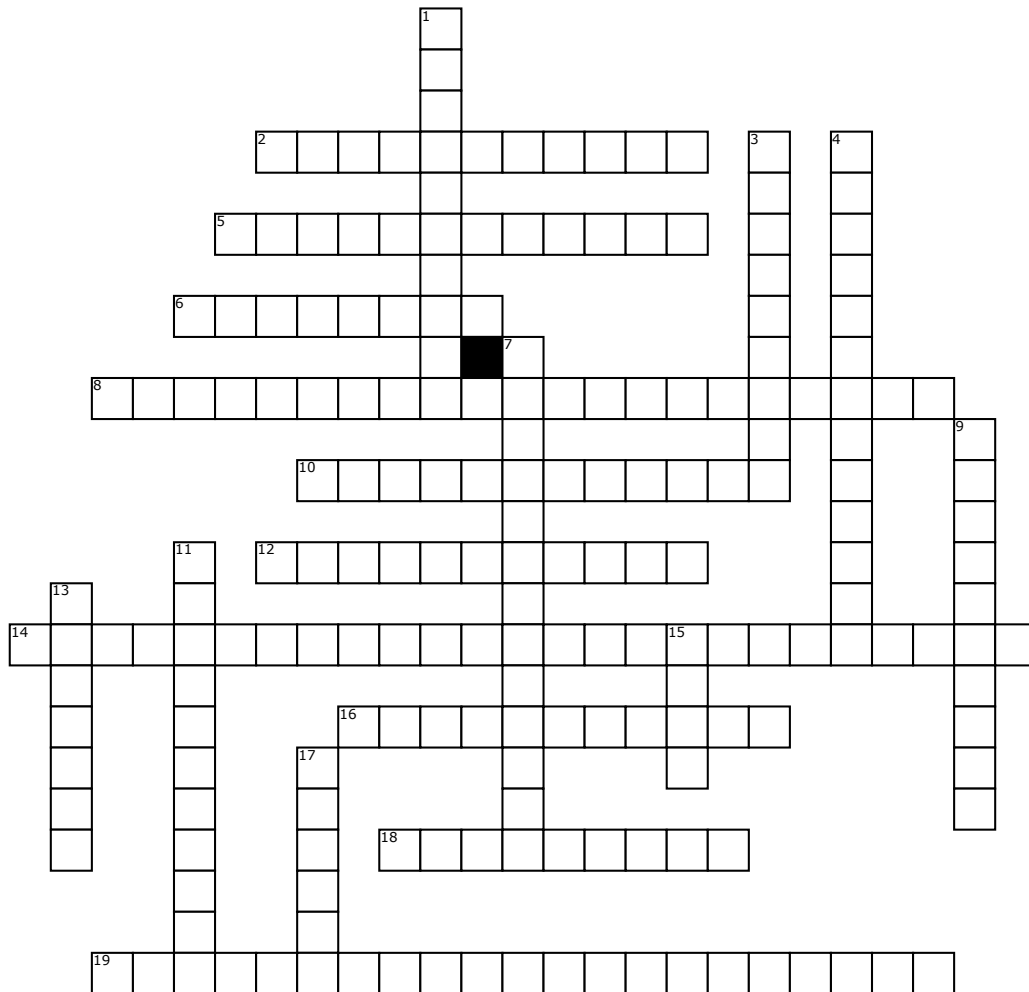


# Ophthalmology Glossary Crossword Part Three



## **Across**

- 2.** Cone shaped cornea  
**5.** The name of the angle between the iris and cornea through which the aqueous humor drains  
**6.** Low intraocular pressure  
**8.** Leukocytes adhering to the corneal endothelium  
**10.** Trembling of the iris with eye movement. This indicates lens luxation or subluxation  
**12.** Excision of parts of the cornea

- 14.** Keratitis and conjunctivitis secondary to decreased lacrimal gland secretion  
**16.** Production of tears  
**18.** A condition where the iris is displaced anteriorly due to collection of aqueous in total posterior synechiae  
**19.** Inflammation of all the layers of the cornea

- 1.** Conic bulging of the lens  
**3.** Inflammation of the cornea

- 4.** Inadequate eyelid closure  
**7.** Inflammation of the iris and ciliary body  
**9.** Removal of part of the iris  
**11.** The term to describe a swollen lens  
**13.** White corneal opacity  
**15.** Colored membrane in front of the lens, the most anterior part of the uvea  
**17.** The boundary between the cornea and the sclera
