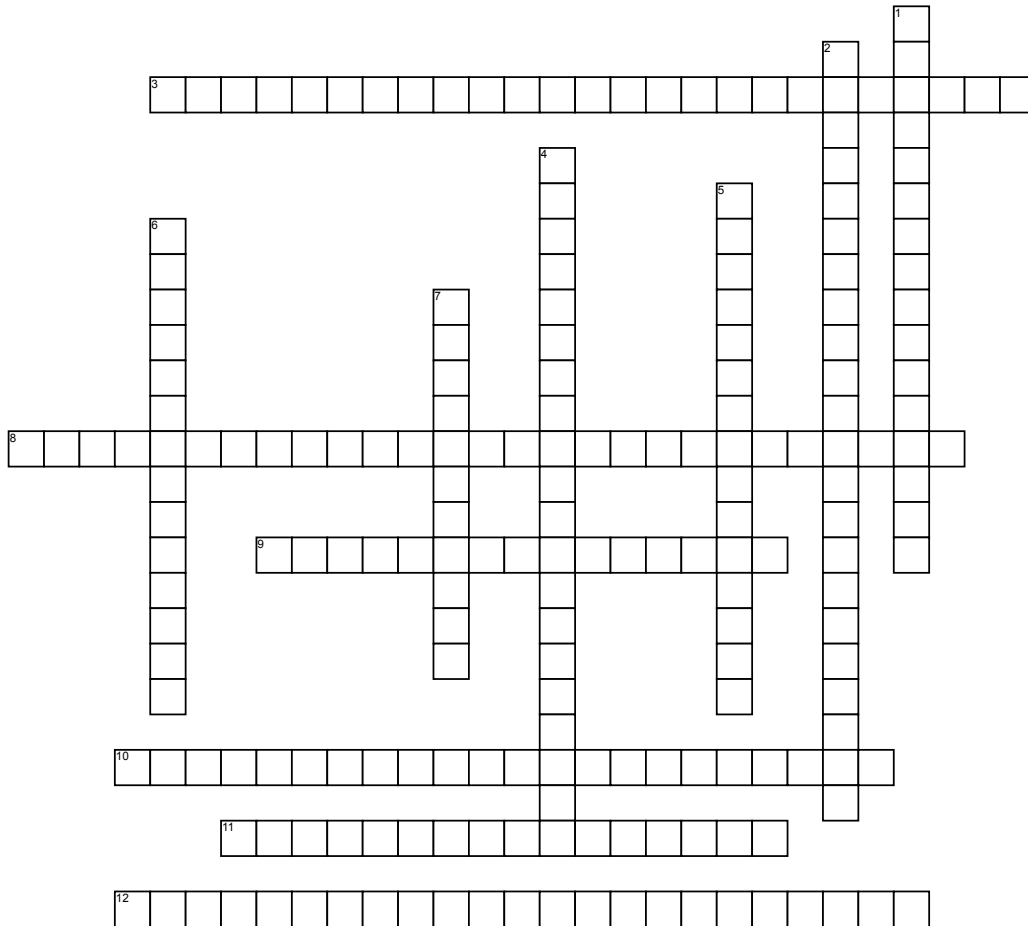


# Options for Education and Training
