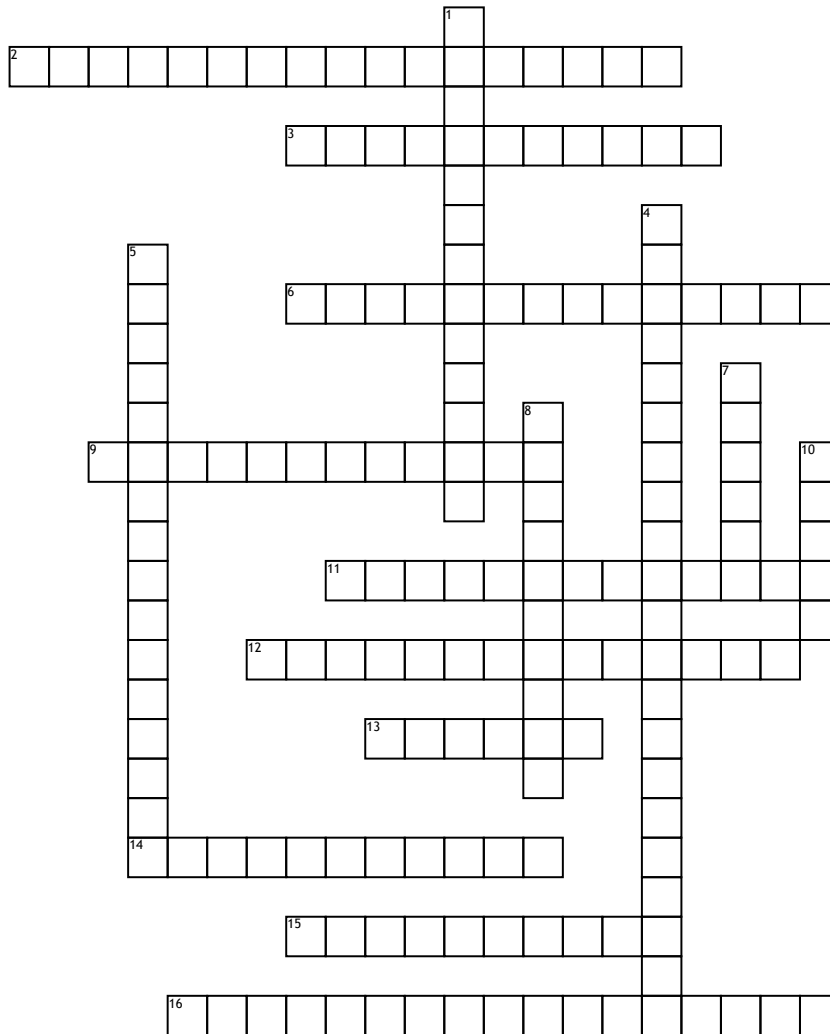

# Organ: Heart



## Across

2. a condition in which the force of the blood against the artery wall is too high  
3. receiving chambers for blood entering the heart  
6. pumps oxygen poor blood to the lungs  
9. opens to increase pressure as the left atrium fills with blood  
11. sudden unexpected loss of heart function

12. responsible for carrying oxygenated blood from the lungs back to the left atrium

13. separates left and right ventricles

14. closes off the lower left chamber, opens to allow blood to leave the heart

15. improper beating of the heart, whether its too fast or slow

16. carry oxygen poor blood to the lungs

## Down

1. pumps oxygen rich blood to the body  
4. damage or disease in the hearts major blood vessels  
5. brings oxygen poor blood from the lower body to the right atrium  
7. damage to the brain from interruption of its blood supply  
8. one of the four chambers and is located on the left side of the heart  
10. carries oxygen rich blood from the left ventricle to the body
