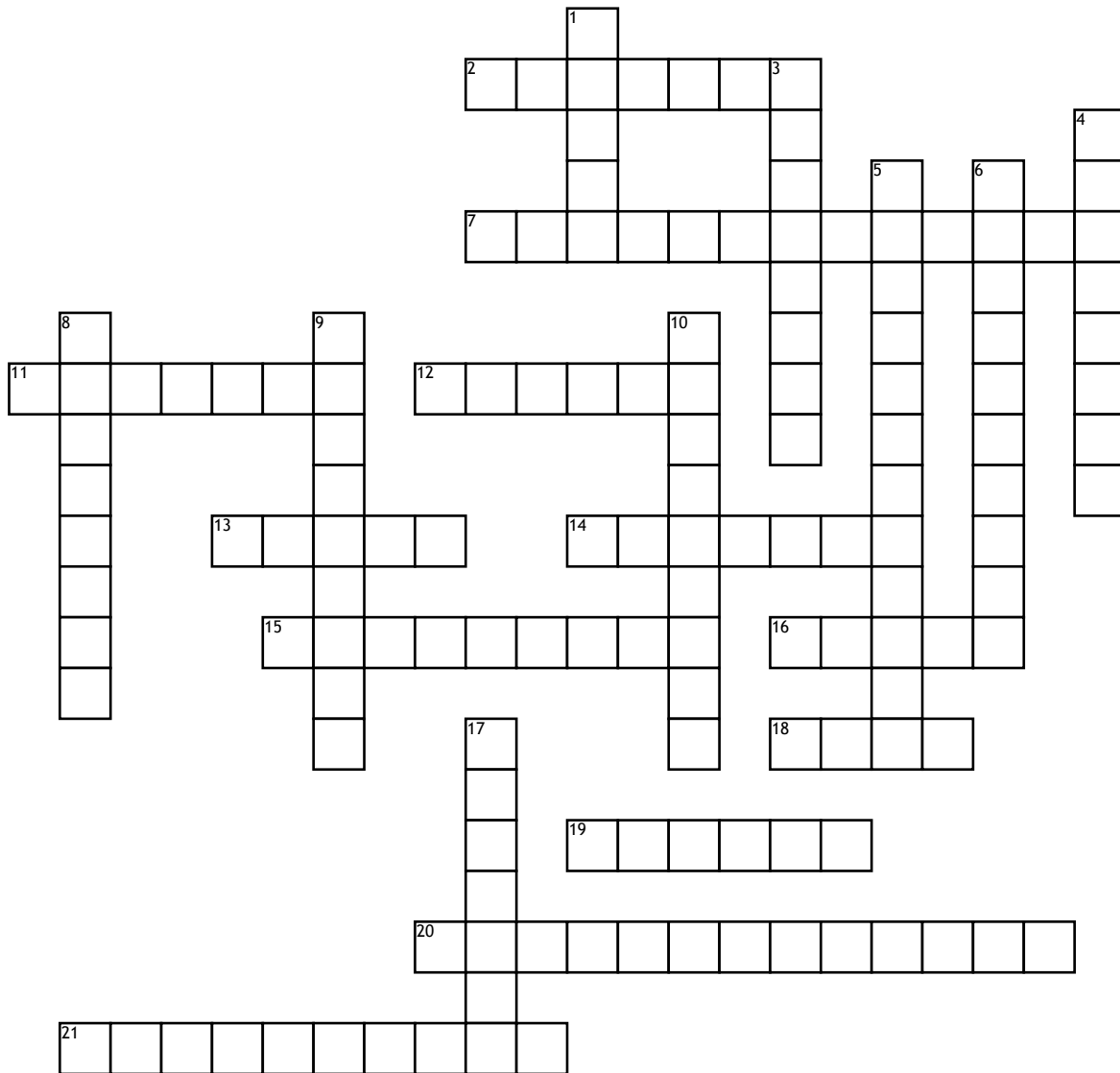


Our Common Home - Puzzle 1
